Sometimes it is difficult to understand some of the concepts or mysteries that we celebrate in the Church. Pentecost and the power of the Holy Spirit can be one of those mysteries. Maybe this little "word picture" can be of assistance.

"I have a glove here in my hand. The glove cannot do anything by itself, but when my hand is in it, it can do many things. True, it is not the glove, but my hand in the glove that acts. We are gloves. It is the Holy Spirit in us which is the hand, who does the job. We have to make room for the hand so that every finger is filled.

The question on Pentecost is not whether God is blessing our own plans and programs but whether we are open to the great opportunities to which his Spirit calls us.

\*\* Tomorrow, Monday after Pentecost, we have a new Feast in the Church. This past February it was declared that the Monday after Pentecost would be the **Feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church.** Pope Francis desired this feast to encourage growth in genuine Marian piety and the "maternal sense of the Church." It is a clear reminder that our Blessed Mother is both Mother of Christ and Mother of the Church. This is not a new title for Mary. Blessed Pope Paul VI gave this title to her in a1964. St. John Paul II had a mosaic of Our Lady commissioned to overlook St. Peter's square after he attributed his life being saved by Our Blessed Mother when shot by an assassin on May 13, 1981. The title under the mosaic reads, Mother of the Church. Let's be specially mindful of the role of our Blessed Mother in our life on Monday. Yes, she has many titles but one that is over all, Mother of the Church!

Pope Francis called it the culmination of Jesus' mission. We celebrate it each year on Pentecost Sunday.

It is the gift of the Holy Spirit -- first given to the apostles and Mary and also given to us.

The apostles were expecting something to happen. Jesus had been saying that He would be leaving them and they asked him where He was going and what He was going to do.

He told them: "you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses...to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8).

Jesus also said: "...it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you." (John 16:7)

We know from sacred scripture what the Holy Spirit did for the apostles on that day and beyond in the development of the early Church.

The Spirit continues to be at work today influencing the Church and all its members.

The Spirit is our Advocate providing each of us with inspiration, power and comfort. This is truly a manifestation of the love of God.

As scripture says, "The love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the holy Spirit that has been given to us" (Romans 5:5)

Do you feel the presence of the Spirit in your life? Is there a way to make more or better use of the power of the Holy Spirit?

Here are some thoughts for consideration.

**Give Thanks.** Just as our young are taught to say "thank you" when receiving a gift, we ought to give thanks to God for the ever-present gift of the Holy Spirit.

**Ask for Help:** Praying for guidance from the Holy Spirit is appropriate when dealing with any decision, difficulty, challenge, or opportunity, large or small.

**Seek and Act:** It's important to recognize the promptings of the Holy Spirit arising in our mind and heart and then respond to them.

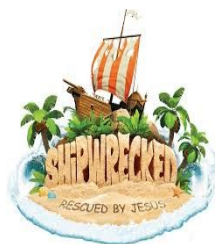
