No one has the right to another person's certificate, except: the parent/guardian of a minor child. (Archdiocese of Detroit)

ANointing OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Today as we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, we hear at Mass sung the great "Sequence" of Pentecost. Many regard this as one of the greatest masterpieces of sacred Latin poetry ever written. Its beauty and depth have been praised by many. The hymn has been attributed to three different authors, King Robert II the Pious of France (970-1031), Pope Innocent III (1161-1216), and Stephen Langton (+1228), Archbishop of Canterbury, of which the last is most likely the author. Ever since the 16th century, this hymn has been part of the Roman Missal. It is wonderful to reflect on the beautiful poetry as you own prayer... and you don't have to sing it.

Veni, Sancte Spiritus

Come, Holy Spirit, come!

And from Your celestial home shed a ray of light divine!

Come, Father of the poor!

Come, source of all our store! Come, within our bosoms shine!

You, of comforters the best;

You, the soul's most welcome Guest; sweet refreshment here below.

In our labor, rest most sweet;

grateful coolness in the heat; solace in the midst of woe.

O most blessed Light divine,

shine within these hearts of Yours, and our inmost being fill!

Where You are not, we have naught,

nothing good in deed or thought,

nothing free from taint of ill.

Heal our wounds, our strength renew;

on our dryness pour Your dew; wash the stains of guilt away;

Bend the stubborn heart and will;

Melt the frozen, warm the chill; guide the steps that go astray.

On the faithful, who adore and confess You,

evermore in Your seven-fold gift descend;

Give them virtue's sure reward;

give them Your salvation, Lord; give them joys that never end.

Amen. Alleluia!

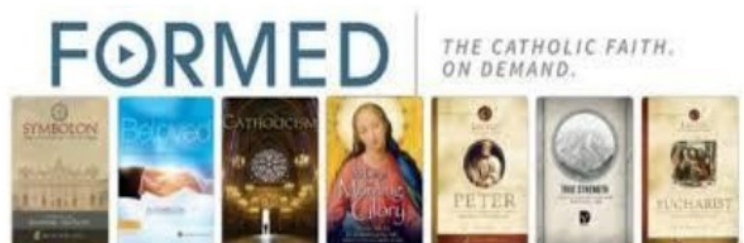
