Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.


Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Bulletin articles are due by 10:00 a.m. on Friday. Submitted bulletin content is subject for approval. Next Sunday is the great feast of Pentecost, the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and the empowerment they received to teach, preach and spread the Good News of Jesus Christ to others. This is always a very powerful celebration in the Church and should be a renewal in each one of us of what our mission is as a Church and as individuals.

It was two years ago, at Pentecost, that Archbishop Vigneron promulgated his Pastoral Letter, Unleash the Gospel, setting forth for the Archdiocese of Detroit a vision or charter as a fruit of the historic Archdiocesan Synod '16. (Synod '16 was the result of three years of prayer and preparation leading up to the Synod.) The overall goal is for the Archdiocese, and each parish, to be "resolved to obey the Holy Spirit and be made by him a band of joyful missionary disciples." This entails a "missionary conversion," a change of culture, through a personal encounter of Jesus. I, and many others, have seen this change in so many aspects already within the Archdiocese of Detroit, within its structure and operation and it is already producing good fruit!

On Saturday, June 8, at the celebration of the Vigil of Pentecost at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral, Archbishop Vigneron will reveal and explain the "next phase" of Unleash the Gospel. If there is to be a joyful band of missionary disciples in southeast Michigan "unleashing the Gospel," it can't just be those working in the downtown offices of the Archdiocese...it obviously needs to involve everyone! Hence, the next phase is to invoke the Holy Spirit in each parish, and then for each parish to respond to the promptings of the Holy Spirit and moving each parish from "maintenance to mission."

In announcing this next phase of *Unleash the Gospel*, Archbishop Vigneron will reveal that ten parishes have been chosen as "partner parishes" to pilot a process whereas each parish will develop an actionable and concrete strategy to focus all parish activity and efforts towards our fundamental commitment to evangelization. Our Lady Star of the Sea has been chosen as



one of the ten "partner parishes" to lead the way for the Archdiocese.

I am happy and grateful that our parish has been selected by the Archbishop for this very important endeavor. It is an honor for us and I know that this process, wherever the Holy Spirit will lead us, will bear fruit here at Star of the Sea.

As the weeks go on during these summer months, I will keep you informed of our progress in developing the strategic plan to be submitted to the AoD in August. Now is the time for us to be engaged in more prayer to the Holy Spirit for our parish, prompting us where we are to go and what we are to do to be as those first disciples, joyful in our mission to teach and preach Jesus to others.

** As next Sunday is Pentecost, I ask two things. One, if possible, wear red to Mass next weekend. Two, bring a red geranium to church and then we will use them to enhance our campus!

** Saturday, the Vigil of Pentecost, is Ordination day for the Archdiocese of Detroit. Three men will be ordained for service in the AoD. Please pray for these men who are to be ordained priests: John McKenzie, Adam Nowak, and Derik Peterman.

** Congratulations to our 8th grade graduates, as well as our graduates from high school, college and other distinguished programs. Be open to the Lord's guidance in your future and know the power of the Holy Spirit to inspire and encourage you!

Enthusiasm for the message! Energy to act!

These are some of the feelings generated from our recent parish mission. You can sense this even by listening to the talks now if you were not able to attend. They are still available on our parish website.

Fr. Steven Bell, a Paulist priest, talked about various types of relationships and how they can grow, thrive, break, be repaired, and survive.

One thing that is necessary in all good relationships is communication. This is not something new. However, applying it to our relationship with God in the way Fr. Bell suggested may be.

The idea is to take a little break from what we're doing 5 times a day, for just 3 minutes each time. First, take a deep breath. Then, formulate a very short



prayer saying how you feel and what you need from God. During the rest of the time, try to feel His presence in some way.

The benefits are bringing God more into our day by letting Him be the first to know what is going well or poorly plus what is desired. It also helps build awareness of the power of prayer.

I view this as just one part of developing a "personal relationship" with God. Obviously, this idea could be adapted to the individual and still achieve the same or similar benefits.

This was just one aspect of the talks which we pray will assist individuals and our community in our parish mission: With Mary, we bring people to Christ, to live the love of God.
