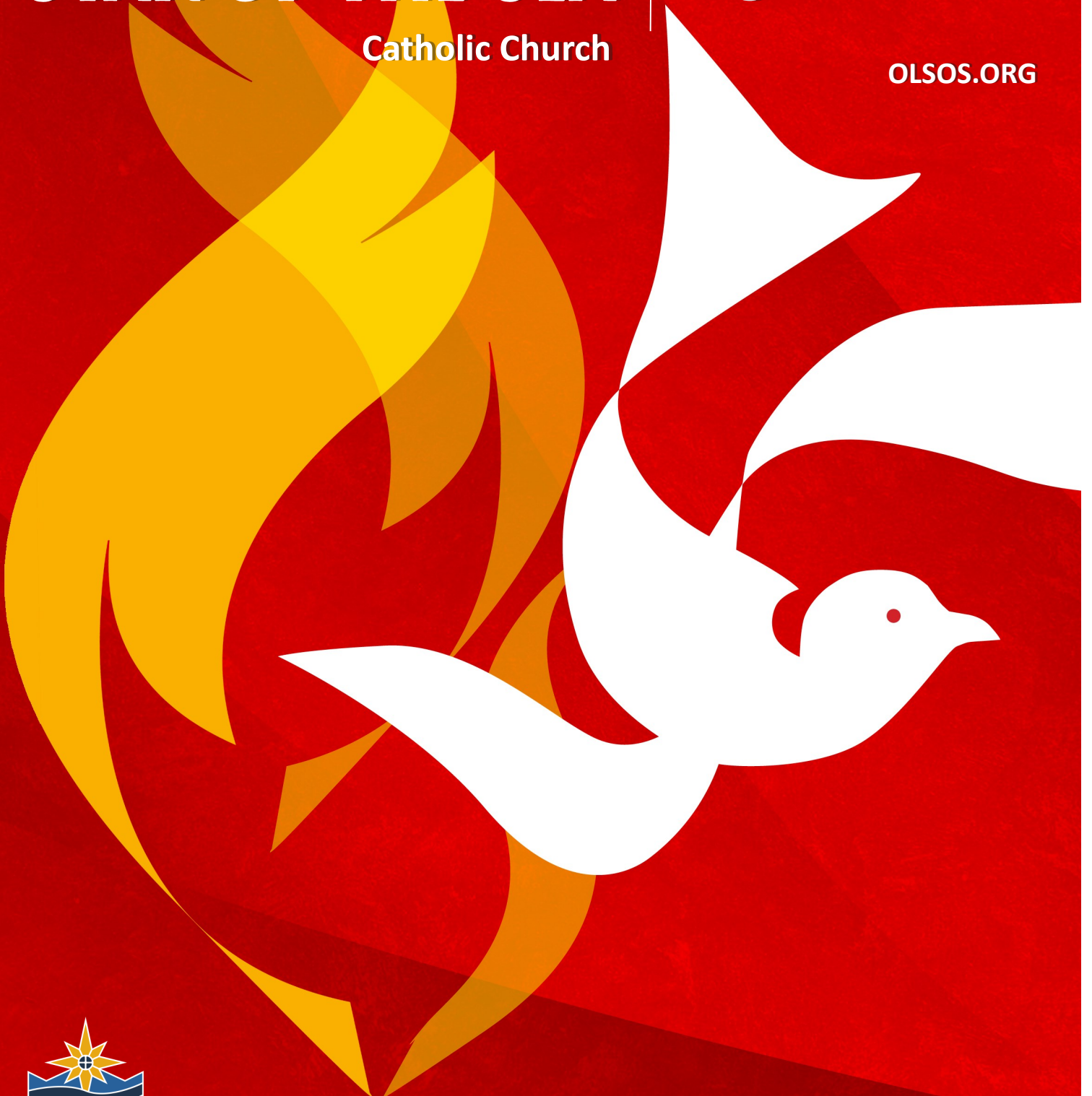

Today we celebrate the great Feast of Pentecost and bring to a close the Easter Season. Pentecost is often referred to as the "Birthday of the Church," as the apostles were sent forth, empowered by the Spirit, to continue preaching and teaching the Kingdom of God just as Jesus had taught them.

We too are reminded of our mission – being sent forth with the power of the Holy Spirit to be the living presence of Christ in the world. We know it is a tough task at times – even more so why we need to call upon the Holy Spirit to strengthen us in all that we do.

As I mentioned last week in this space, in announcing the next phase of *Unleash the Gospel*, Archbishop Vigneron has chosen ten parishes as "partner parishes" to pilot a process whereas each parish will develop an actionable and concrete strategy to focus all parish activity and efforts towards our fundamental commitment to evangelization. Our Lady Star of the Sea has been chosen as one of the ten "partner parishes" to lead the way for the Archdiocese.

I am happy and grateful that our parish has been selected by the Archbishop for this very important endeavor. It is an honor for us and I know that this process, wherever the Holy Spirit will lead us, will bear fruit here at Star of the Sea.

The Archdiocese of Detroit is providing great guidance and help for this "re-founding" of each parish as envisioned by Synod 16. As a part of this process, each parish has a Parish Visionary Team (PVT) to pray to the Holy Spirit for guidance, formulate a strategic plan that will move the parish from "maintenance to mission, listen to what the Holy Spirit is saying, and then finalize the plan as seen and directed by the Holy Spirit. I am happy that our PVT comprises of Annie Schunior, Judy Zedan, Kerry Vlahantones, Bill Bolton and me. In this pilot phase, we also have two "missionaries" from the Archdiocese, well versed in *Unleash the Gospel*, to help guide us through the process. Please pray for us pray for the parish as well! By the time you



read this we will have had our first meeting, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit!

In this bulletin you will find the prayer for this "next phase" of *Unleash the Gospel*. Please pray it...daily if you can! You will also find a letter from the Archbishop regarding this next phase.

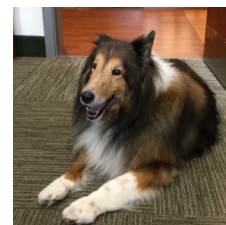
Great things are happening within the Archdiocese and I am confident great things will continue to happen here at Star of the Sea as we unleash the Gospel to our community!

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Praise be to Jesus Christ, now and forever! At the first Pentecost, Christ came to his apostles and breathed onto them the transforming power of the Holy Spirit. He breathes on us today, his faithful in the Archdiocese of Detroit.

We find ourselves very much like the apostles who were gathered in a room. Like them, our hearts rejoice when we encounter Jesus. Like them, he sends us on a mission and gives us his Holy Spirit so that we may go out and Unleash the Gospel.

God is pouring out his Spirit so we can continue the work of the apostles. The Spirit enables us to proclaim the Good News to those in our families, workplaces and communities. The Holy Spirit, our Advocate, gives us the courage to continue our missionary journey.

And on this day, I would like to announce the **next phase of our movement to Unleash the Gospel: the renewal of our parishes**. For the Gospel to truly be unleashed, we must re-found our parishes so that everything we do— how we pray, how we minister, how we serve— leads us to be more effective witnesses to the Gospel.

**This next phase of our missionary journey will require prayer, innovation, and hard work so that our parish communities become what God made them to be:** places where individuals and families encounter Jesus anew, grow as his disciples, and are equipped to be witnesses of the Risen Christ.

To spark this transformation, each parish in the Archdiocese will create a plan to realign all its activity and ministry to our shared mission to Unleash the Gospel. These missionary strategic plans will provide the direction and focus for each parish's missionary transformation.

Today, ten parishes in the Archdiocese will begin the process of creating these plans. I am grateful for the apostolic courage of these first pastors and their parishes. Other parishes will follow early next year and more will continue after.

### go and make disciples

*"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded of you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."* Mt. 28:19-20

**Happy Birthday!!** Today we celebrate the birthday of the Church and the end of the 50 days of the Easter season. Pentecost Sunday is a commemoration and celebration of the receiving of the Holy Spirit by the early church. Before He ascended to heaven, Jesus commissioned His apostles to go and make disciples. The Holy Spirit gave the apostles gifts of grace through which they would undertake that evangelical mission. These last words of Jesus are a pretty good mission statement for us. This command is the fundamental basis of our faith—to bring the Good News of Christ's salvation to all the world. This means that we can't keep our faith a secret. Our faith can't be invisible or confined to the Catholic community or the property boundaries of our parish.

The disciples didn't have it easy when they went into the world to profess the Good News. But we don't either.

It's easier to just follow rules than to use Jesus' approach of examining our own hearts to determine our motives and attitudes behind our actions. Jesus taught that the Kingdom of God

was about relationships and love.

Evangelization means not blending into the culture and keeping our faith to ourselves. It's putting our faith in action, giving us a chance to touch lives and be a larger part of the Christian community.

Jesus didn't just preach, he healed the sick, raised the dead, encouraged the weary and sad, and forgave sins, giving people fresh starts. He taught by doing.

While Catholic dogma and doctrine remain steadfast, the manner in which a Catholic parish catechizes and evangelizes is developed through a vision that is its own. The manner in which we spread the Good News is unique to each one of us.

If you look, you will see that there are many, many opportunities for formation, faith building, outreach, community and spiritual inspiration and living God's love inside the Church and in our culture.

We have been given the gifts of grace from the Holy Spirit to evangelize. We have the answer for the things that are wrong in the world--it is Christ.

Now that's great news. Let's share it!

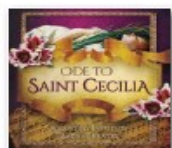
Annually, since 2009, Star has hosted a
