Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.





Reporting Sexual Misconduct Involving Bishops

The Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting Service (CBAR) has been established to receive reports of sexual abuse and related misconduct by bishops, and to relay those reports to proper Church authorities for investigation. In the Archdiocese of Detroit, as in all U.S. dioceses, an independent, third-party entity provides secure, confidential intake services. Individuals may go to ReportBishopAbuse.org or call (800) 276-1562 to make a report.

Information on reporting sexual abuse and related misconduct by archdiocesan priests, deacons or other church representatives is available at protect.aod.org. In all cases, victims of sexual abuse are urged to contact law enforcement.
