The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

UNLEASH THE GOSPEL

Pope Francis has spoken about three visits of the Lord to humanity.

The first visit was when He became man and was born in Bethlehem.

The second visit is the present! It is when He "visits us constantly, each day, walking alongside us and being a consoling presence".

The third is when, as we say in the Creed, "He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead."

He visits us each and every day, more than once, constantly! He is at our door!

Do we answer? Do we let Him in? Do we get to know Him better?

If we want to build upon our current relationship with Him, here are four areas to consider.

His Word in Scripture: reading His Word, reflecting on it, listening to what He is saying to us, and resolving to live by it.

The Mass: prayerfully attending Mass and receiving Him in the Eucharist.

Prayer: praying that includes adoring Him, thanking Him, asking for forgiveness, asking for His will in our own needs or in the needs of others, and listening to Him.

Treatment of Others: loving and serving the poor, the sick, and the suffering; bringing comfort to those who are hurting, etc.

May you remember each day that the Lord is walking beside you. May you be strengthened by His presence.

FORMING OUR FAITH

Be the Domestic Church—Part 5 Teach Tolerance



In the Catholic tradition, the family holds a special place--especially in the formation of faith. So important, in fact, that the family is called "the domestic church."

One of the main concerns parents have for their children is that they learn the lessons and skills they will need to succeed in the world they will inherit. An important part of that formula for success is learning to interact well with others in a culturally diverse society, learning tolerance and appreciation for persons who observe customs and beliefs that may be very different from those we are comfortable and grew up with.

Many tips for parents can be distilled down to setting a good example and be good role models for the behavior they would like to see in their children by treating others well themselves. And that includes the kids, too. A child who receives unflinching warmth and love from his or her parents is likely to bring that sense first and foremost into their relationships with others.

Two of the tips, though, seem to clearly address the special challenges and responsibilities that teaching tolerance presents to Catholic and all Christian parents. These suggestions are "Learn together about holiday and religious celebrations that are not part of your own tradition," and "Honor your family's traditions and teach them to your kids—and to someone outside the family who wants to learn about the diversity you have to offer."

It all comes down to honoring a Creator who loves all of His people. God created us and Jesus died and rose again to save all of us, those who are just like us and those who are different from us. *See you in Church!*

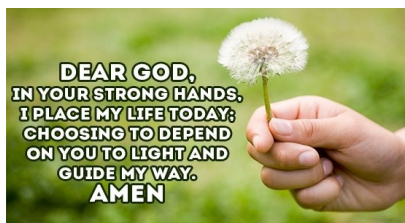
