## UNLEASH THE GOSPEL

### go and make disciples

Individuals and families have a big interest these days in genealogy and going back to their roots.

As discussed in a prior article, we at Our Lady Star of the Sea are a parish family and part of the Church which is the family of God.

So, what if we were to go back to our roots?

Actually, that process has already begun.

It began four years ago when Archbishop Vigneron announced a year of prayer for a new Pentecost. It continued with a number of activities leading up to Synod 16 that was held in November 2016. It was later defined in his pastoral letter, Unleash the Gospel, the charter for the future of the Church in our archdiocese.

These steps were needed because over time, part of our focus had lessened. While still actively working on our relationship with God and our goal of eternal life, we had not emphasized the missionary nature of the Church that Jesus established.

The commission made by Jesus to "go and make disciples" was the mandate for all members of the family of God. It means sharing the good news of Christ's love in word and deed with whomever we can.

We continue to work on our spiritual relationship with God through prayer, the sacraments and scripture reading, along with our good works.

St. Paul's Letter to the Ephesians describes the early Church. He reminds them of God's plan of salvation and how to lead a Christian life. In doing so, Paul presents much about the Church itself that is very relevant to what is happening in our archdiocese now.

*"The missionary conversion to which the Lord calls us is new, yet it is also a return to the roots of our identity as the Church of Jesus Christ. It is a reawakening to our foundational calling, applied in a new way to the specific circumstances and challenges of our time."* (Unleash the Gospel)

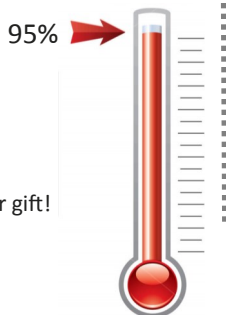

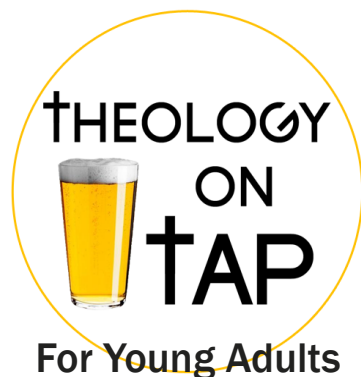

# FORMING OUR FAITH

## *Be the Domestic Church—Part 6* *Do Unto Others*



In the Catholic tradition, the family holds a special place—especially in the formation of faith. So important, in fact, that the family is called "the domestic church." As stated in the Catechism of the Catholic Church #2223, "Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. They bear witness to this responsibility first by creating a home where tenderness, forgiveness, respect, fidelity, and disinterested service are the rule."

Disinterested service—helping others when there is no perceived reward—is a central tenet of our faith and it's also great for your child's spiritual health. When Colleen Burke, a Catholic mom in Rockford, IL, started volunteering for Meals on Wheels last year, she brought along Kate, 6, and Will, 4. "We went to poor neighborhoods and met people who were too weak to leave their apartments," Burke says. "My kids could see how lucky they were to have warm clothes and enough to eat, and how satisfying it was to share our good fortune. That spoke louder to them than a sermon."

In both our parish and community there are many charitable opportunities for you and your children to participate in. The Christian Service Outreach at Star this month is collecting school supplies. Take your child on a shopping trip and have them pick out supplies for a child without the means to provide their own pencils, markers, binders, backpacks, etc. Have your child to write a note to put inside the backpack that they are praying that the recipient has a great school year.

When you encourage your child to ride a bike in a cancer bike-a-thon, ladle soup at a shelter, or sell lemonade to help needy kids, you teach them that all people are family—perhaps the best lesson of all.
