The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Does God speak to you?

Some would answer with "yes", or "no", or "I'm not sure". Others would say that God speaks to us in Sacred Scripture or His Word.

This question is really meant about whether God speaks to you personally.

As we delve into this question, it is important to recognize that this is not about some extraordinary event, such as what St. Paul or some of the prophets experienced.

One way that God speaks to us is through His Word or Sacred Scripture. Through scripture, we learn a lot about our God. The more we read, the more we learn about Him – His love for us, His mercy, why He created us, His laws or commandments, His plan for us, and His Son who was sent to teach us how to live and who is our salvation.

More than being simply a source of information, His Word becomes an avenue for God speaking to us personally. This happens if we take the time to reflect on what a particular passage means for us personally -- how it can and should affect our life.

UNLEASH THE GOSPEL

Some writers point out that God has a number of other ways He uses to communicate with us. These are ways that we find meaningful -- that we can understand with our human nature.

In addition to prayer, homilies, devotions, and spiritual reading, consider things like events, people, and nature, for example.

Are they or can they be God speaking to us?

Can certain events in our lives cause action or change on our part?

What influence can other people have on us based on what they say or do?

Does nature help us more fully recognize God's presence?

Could it be that we are like Samuel who thought it was Eli calling during the night? It was the Lord calling, but Samuel didn't recognize Him.

Maybe we don't recognize God speaking to us.
