
Saint John Paul II

#### ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

#### **MARRIAGE**

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

#### **PARISH REGISTRATION**

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes. Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

He said her passing united the vast majority of people, like 911, the assignation of JFK and Pearl Harbor. Mitch went on to say, "Ginsburg was once asked how she'd like to be remembered. She said as someone who helped society behind her own self-interest, who did things 'outside myself'. Maybe we can learn from that. Because it's the opposite of how most of us are acting right now."






