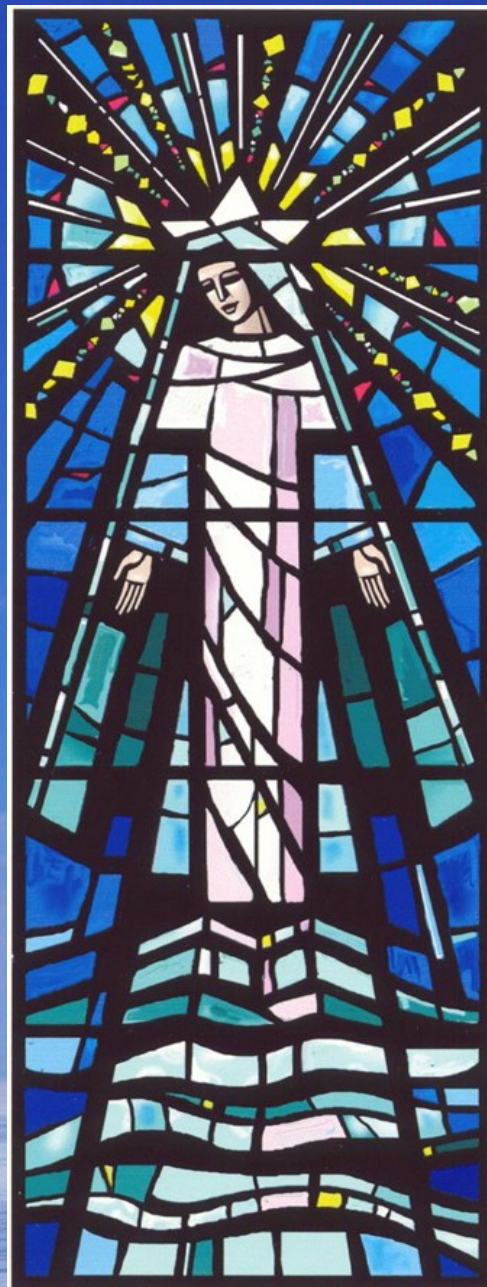
*O Mary, Star of the Sea,

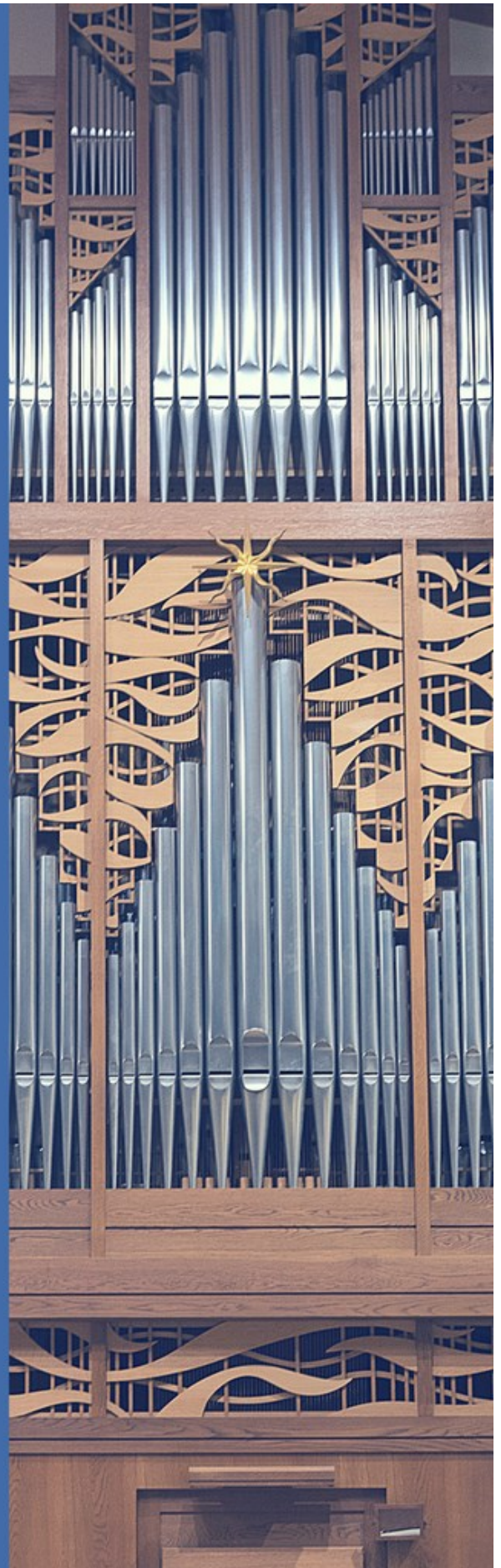

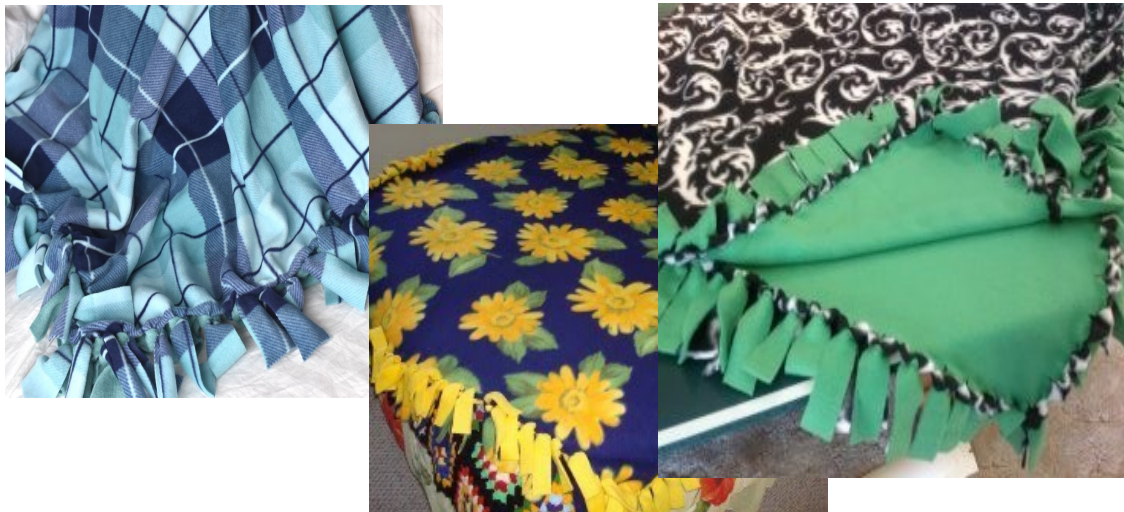

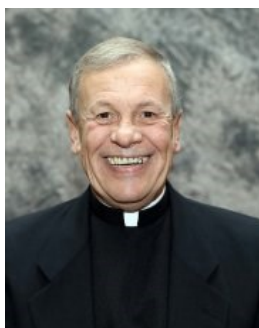

# UNLEASH THE GOSPEL

## go and make disciples

When asked "what parish do you belong to?" most of us here say "Star." When choosing logos, images and tag lines for various uses we often center on that word and all its implications...shining, bright, etc.

This weekend we are celebrating our parish feast day and honoring Mary, Our Lady Star of the Sea in a special way.

Our Lady, Star of the Sea is an ancient title for the Blessed Mother. The Latin title Stella Maris, Star of the Sea, was used as early as the ninth century. The title was used to emphasize Mary's role as a sign of hope and as a guiding star for Christians, especially gentiles, whom the Old Testament Israelites metaphorically referred to as the sea, meaning anyone beyond the "coasts" or outside of the sociopolitical and Mosaic law borders of Israel.

For centuries sailors sought the protection of the Blessed Virgin under the title "Stella Maris", "Star of the Sea".

The origin of the expression "Stella Maris" is commonly attributed to St. Jerome in the fifth century.

There are some ancient Marian hymns related to the title. The beautiful hymn by Fr. John Lingard "Hail Queen of Heaven, the Ocean Star" is being sung regularly at our Masses and is found inside the back cover of our hymnal.

There is a chaplet of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

a variation of the traditional rosary. The chaplet has a medal of Our Lady of Carmel, three separate beads, and twelve additional beads.

Although Our Lady Star of the Sea is commonly thought of as the patroness of those who sail the seas, according to Saint Bonaventure she is also the one who guides to a landfall in heaven those who navigate the sea of this world in the "ship of innocence or penance."

Our Lady aids not only sailors, but also all of us who sail the stormy and not so stormy seas of life. The following is a twelfth-century prayer from St Bernard of Clairvaux:

*If the winds of temptation arise;  
If you are driven upon the rocks of tribulation  
look to the star, call on Mary;  
If you are tossed upon the waves of pride, of  
ambition, of envy, of rivalry, look to the star,  
call on Mary.*

Let's look to "the Star" as we pray, work and play so that all our efforts will glorify God.
