Today, Sunday, October 20, our Confirmation candidates, along with their sponsors, will be participating in a morning retreat praying together, discussing the role of the sponsor as a mentor in the faith, and learning more about the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit. They will also have time to brainstorm ideas for Mercy Experiences that they

might be able to do together. What are Mercy Experiences? One of the ways that God asks us to love others is through service. While the secular world may require service hours as a way of developing good citizens and instilling an upright ethical attitude, Catholics engage in service as a way of extending God's mercy to others and sharing one another's burdens. As such, they are not service projects but *experiences* of God's enduring *mercy*.

The candidates and sponsors will take time to reflect on the hopes and plans they have to continue on this lifelong journey of faith as they prepare together for the Sacrament of Confirmation in April.

Following the retreat, the candidates and sponsors will join our parish family at the 11:30 am Mass where they will participate in the Rite of Enrollment—writing their name in the parish book of Confirmandi to indicate that they are ready to take this next step and accept the responsibilities it entails.
