**Bulletin articles are due by 10:00 a.m. on Friday. Submitted bulletin content is subject for approval.**

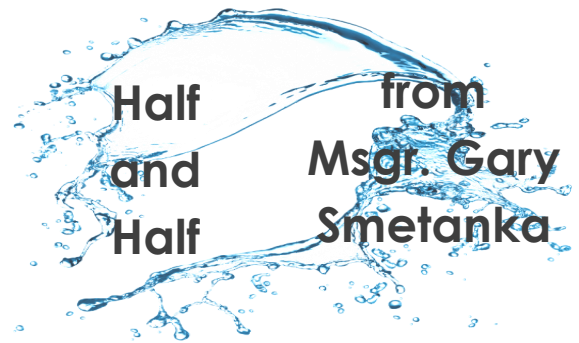
November. Here it is. I see November as a time of change. We see the change in our earthly surroundings with the falling leaves, the hard frost, the cooler temperature (and hopefully no snow) and the time that ends with our holiday of Thanksgiving.

November has traditionally been a time in the Church when we pause and become more mindful of our beloved faithful departed. The Church provides very fitting readings as we will hear more about the end of time and harvesting of all the souls by God. This too, puts into focus for me a time of change, i.e., a change from our earthly life into, hopefully, our heavenly life. I think as we pray for the dead this month, and even visit their places of eternal rest, it helps us to ultimately put things in the right perspective and acknowledges we are God's creatures and He should be the center of our life, striving to do His will for our eternal peace and rest.

As we remember the dead this month, it is a natural time to provide a little catechesis or instruction about Catholic funerals. People often have questions about cremation, or why eulogies are not allowed within a funeral Mass, or other Catholic practices that are normative for a funeral. (Personally, I am very thankful the church has a standard funeral ritual whether it is for a prince or pauper and we don't have to "put together a funeral" every time someone dies.) I invite you to go to [www.aod.org](http://www.aod.org), enter "funerals" in the search box, and then you will find 20 question/answers that I hope you will find informative as well as helpful.

\*\* Please consider our Eucharistic Holy Hour Monday night at 7:30 pm. Our prayer will help us reflect more on these wonderful themes of November!

\*\* Tuesday night at 7 pm we have a training session for those who would like to become Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion. (You might have also seen that we are often short of the ministers we need to distribute Holy Communion at Mass.) If you are

This past Friday, the Church celebrated All Saints Day. In years past, Pope Francis has started his homily saying "Happy Feast Day" to the congregation. It is a reminder that through our Baptism, we are all able to become saints.

We tend to think of saints as being holy, but happiness doesn't necessarily come to mind. Saints were regular people, like you and me. Their days were filled with joys, sorrows, difficulties, challenges, and hopes. However, they followed Christ with a life of faith that was filled with love of others. And that is what made them happy.

Pope Francis said: "True happiness is being with the Lord and living for love...Do you believe this? We must go forth, believing in this. So, the ingredients for a happy life are called Beatitudes: blessed are the simple, the humble who make room for God, who are able to weep for others and for their own mistakes, who remain meek, fight for justice, are merciful to all, safeguard purity of heart, always work

for peace and abide in joy, do not hate and, even when suffering, respond to evil with good."

This is what a true Christian life is. It is a willingness to allow the graces received at our Baptism to be used in ways the Lord intends for each of us personally: loving the Lord and living the Beatitudes.

That is the answer to our desire for happiness. It is living the Gospel and bringing Christ to every person and situation we encounter. It is unleashing the Gospel. It is the path toward sainthood.
