Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

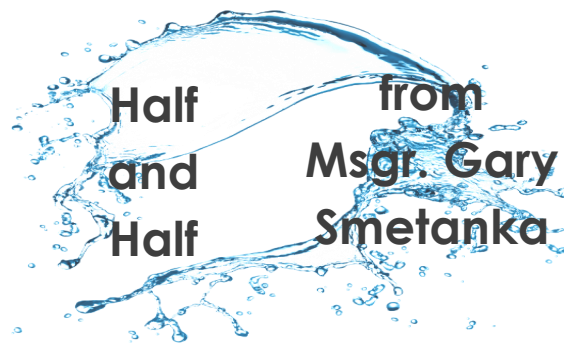

Many wondered how Pope Francis had chosen his name. As he explained to a group of reporters soon after his election, he was sitting next to a Cardinal who was also a close friend. As his name was announced, one of the things his friend did was to say to him “Don’t forget the poor.”

He immediately thought of St. Francis of Assisi and then peace for which he is also known. “For me, he is the man of poverty, the man of peace, the man who loves and protects creation.”

St. Francis of Assisi did many things to promote peace at home and beyond. In 1219, he even traveled from Italy to the Holy Land and on to Egypt, crossing battle lines, in pursuit of peace. During his papacy, Pope Francis has spoken, advocated and travelled for peace on numerous occasions.

When peace is mentioned, the thought of war quickly comes to mind. But, there is a lot more to it. We can have internal peace or be “at peace” with something. And there is external peace.

One of the Beatitudes is “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God”. Pope Francis encouraged us to live the Beatitudes in our daily lives in “Rejoice and Be Glad: The Call to Holiness in Today’s World.” He said that the call to holiness is for everyone, each in their own way and it can be done in today’s world with all our roles and responsibilities. He challenges us to think about each Beatitude in new ways.

Being a peacemaker in today’s world is about seeking peace and harmony in any situation we encounter. This is not an easy task and it can involve some work. Pope Francis points out that it is not just being peaceful ourselves, but can require addressing disagreements or conflict. And that is where work comes in.

“Make me a channel of your peace” is the first line of the Hymn from the Prayer of St. Francis. The following lines of the hymn contain several examples of what we can do.

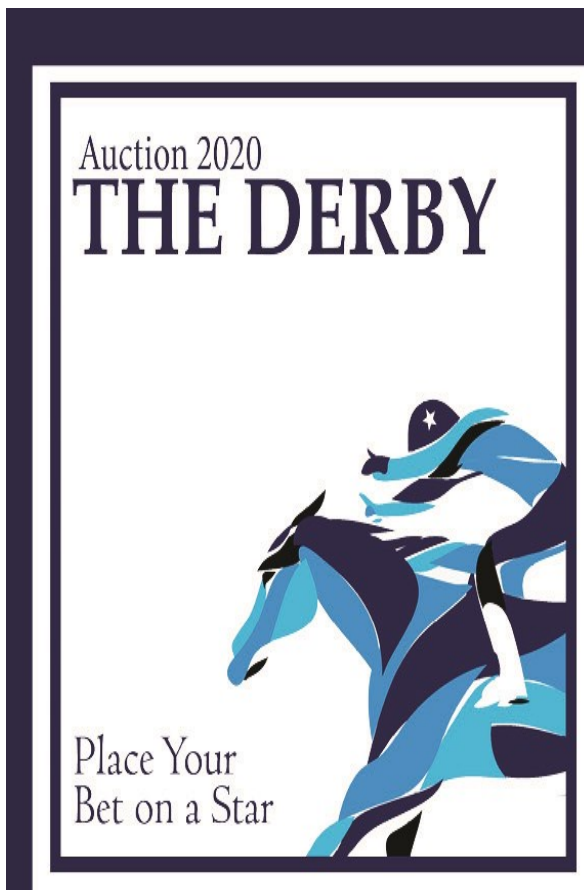
