MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

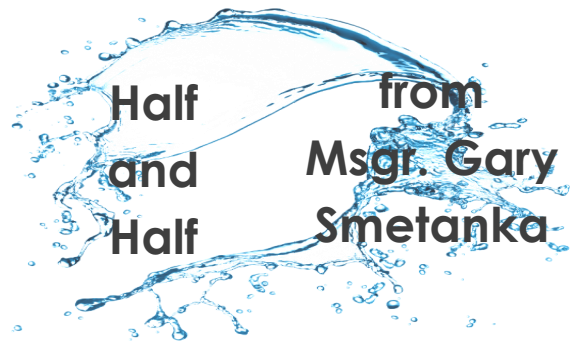

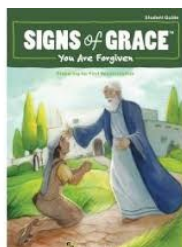

The Sacrament of Reconciliation

Our second grade students are being prepared to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation soon using a new program called

Signs of Grace, You are Forgiven.

The children are learning that God created us to be in friendship with Him, but that friendship was lost through sin. In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, an important part of God's saving plan, He gives us His mercy and brings us back into friendship with Him when we sin.

As stated in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, "The role of parents in education is of such importance that it is almost impossible to provide an adequate substitute." [CCC 2221] With that in mind, this program offers 3 parent formation meetings featuring the video study *Forgiven: The Transforming Power of Confession*, designed for adult faith formation to help strengthen the parents' understanding of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and to challenge them to rediscover the purpose and meaning of the sacrament in their own lives. Our greatest hope is that all families will go to Confession together frequently, making this a regular part of their lives.

A great way to keep in touch with the Lord is to do a Daily Examen which "examines" the following elements in our lives:

- ⇒ Thanksgiving
- ⇒ Petition for others
- ⇒ Review of my day
- ⇒ Response
- ⇒ A Look Ahead

UNLEASH THE GOSPEL

go and make disciples

Although it's been over 30 years since the Catholic Church began calling for a New Evangelization, many Catholics are only now coming to understand that call is for them, not just priests and religious. The whole point of the Unleash the Gospel initiative is to inspire and encourage each Catholic in our archdiocese to evangelize.

Unleash the Gospel is a new response to Christ's command to go and teach all nations. Many have felt that being evangelical meant being of a certain Protestant denomination. However, being evangelical is not a new thing for Catholics. The real oxymoron is the "non-evangelical Catholic." Through all of our salvation history evangelizing was key to the Church's growth.

There are many fine role models and examples of evangelical Catholics over the centuries. In more recent history, one stands out, Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen.

A couple of years ago I was in California visiting my sisters. We went to the Crystal Cathedral, now Christ Cathedral, which had recently been bought by the Diocese of Orange. Our guide asked us who the first televangelist was. We, all Catholics, answered Billy Graham, etc. In fact, the first televangelist was Archbishop Sheen who pioneered

religious radio in 1950! He hosted the first-ever religious telecast and his program, Life is Worth Living, reached approximately 30 million people each week!

As evangelizing Catholics, we don't need to be like Archbishop Sheen. We might be more like Blessed Fr. Solanus Casey. As evangelizing Catholics, no matter what our age, we must: Know our Catholic faith. You cannot live your faith if you do not know it, and you cannot share with others what you do not first make your own. Live our Catholic faith. Your Catholic faith is a public thing. It is not meant to be left behind when you leave your home or church.

Spread our Catholic faith. Jesus Christ wants us to bring the whole world to the truth and the truth is Jesus Himself. Spreading the faith is a job for all Catholics. The mission of evangelization is as old as the Church herself, going back to the Great Commission when Jesus sent out the first disciples with these words: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations...."

This is our great challenge—and our great privilege. "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!" (Romans 10:15).
