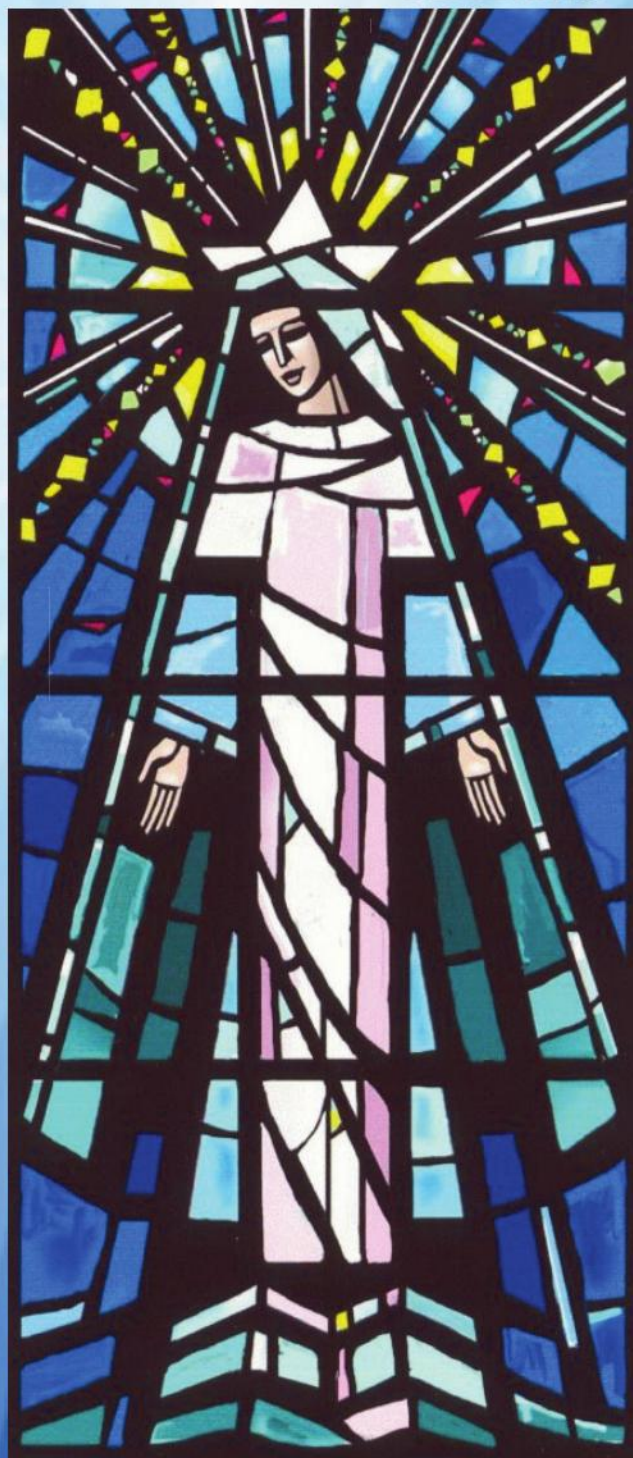

ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka



This weekend we celebrate the 67th anniversary of the founding of Our Lady Star of the Sea parish. It was on June 26, 1954 that this parish was established to bring Christ to others and spread the Good News in this specific corner of the Archdiocese of Detroit.

Sixty-seven years in Church's "time" is not greatly significant, especially since the Church universal has many "church" buildings hundreds of years old and people are still gathering in those churches or parishes to worship and as a community they advance the Kingdom of God. Nonetheless, we know 67 years for us is rather significant! From starting with a small gathering of new parishioners, coming from our other surrounding sister parishes, we have grown nicely in this part of town. The importance of our faith these many years brought forth an elementary and middle school and eventually an all girls high school. Unfortunately, as with so many schools in the 70s and 80s, the high school had to close. However the pursuance of academic excellence continues in our elementary and middle school, and accredited school of excellence, a hidden gem in the GP community! Our outreach to the community continues. Our gathering as a worshipping community continues to challenge and enhance us as the living Body of Christ! Yes, 67 years of dedicated service, education and worship.

I know a few of you have been around all 67 years and remember when the first Masses were held in Parcels school. Most of you have seen continual improvements in and around our campus to better serve the parish community for years to come. Time marks us as to where we have come from and yet opens the path for our future direction. Christ has always wanted his disciples to bring His message, His timeless Truth and Life, to the present day world as it evolves. May we continue to not only follow the Lord but teach and preach the Risen Christ in new ways so all may come to encounter His living presence. May we, one and all, come to see and encounter Christ and be open to the movement of the Holy Spirit in our life! The Church calls each one of us into this "new evangelization" as we build on our foundation and move toward the future.

Thank you for the time, talent and treasure you provide in support of the parish and its programs and ministries. Without you providing that support, we can not exist. May Our Lady smile upon us as we continue to do all we can to bring others to Christ to live the love of God.

** July 1 is always a big day for some parishes as it begins a new fiscal year and might also bring changes in their clergy. This year, July 1 initiates the Family of Parishes for the Archdiocese of Detroit. The Family of Parishes (FOP) is a new structure for ministry, in response to the prompting of the Holy Spirit, in the Archdiocese of Detroit. About half of the Archdiocese will start their FOP this Thursday. Star of the Sea, along with our family members of St. Joan of Arc, St. Lucy, St. Veronica and St. Basil will start its family ministry next year on July 1, 2022. Please pray this week as the Archdiocese of Detroit begins this new direction to best serve the people in Southeast Michigan. 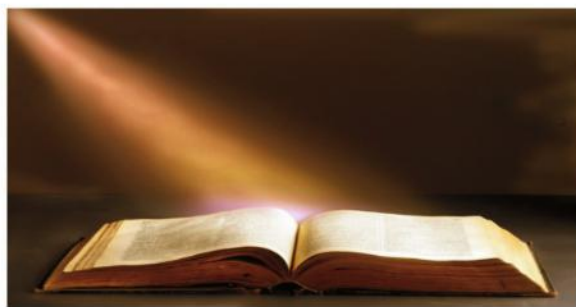

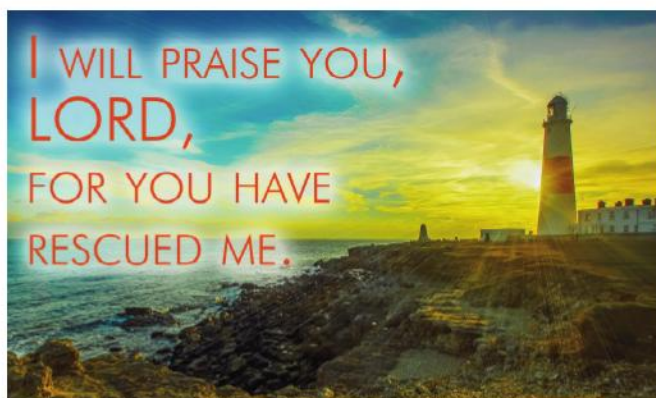

Stewardship Thoughts

In St. Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthian community, he reminds them that they are abundantly blessed in all things through Christ. He encourages them to give from their surplus in relief of others, especially to the struggling Church in Jerusalem. The scribe of the Book of Wisdom professes that our generous God made us in His image. This same teaching is found in the Book of Genesis. The evangelist St. Mark describes in his Gospel how Jesus, moved by demonstrations of deep faith, restored Jairus's daughter to life and cured the woman afflicted with hemorrhages. Do we, as faithful stewards share our many blessings by generously giving to the parish offertory and the Catholic Services Appeal? Do we show Christ-like compassion to our fellow parishioners and brothers and sisters in need?



I warmly encourage the faithful to adore Christ, present in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar, letting him heal our consciences and purify us, enlighten us and unite us." (This begins a series of excerpts from St. John Paul II's message, "His Heart, the Most Outstanding Love," given on the 100th anniversary of the Consecration of the Human Race to the Divine Heart of Jesus, June 4, 1999)
