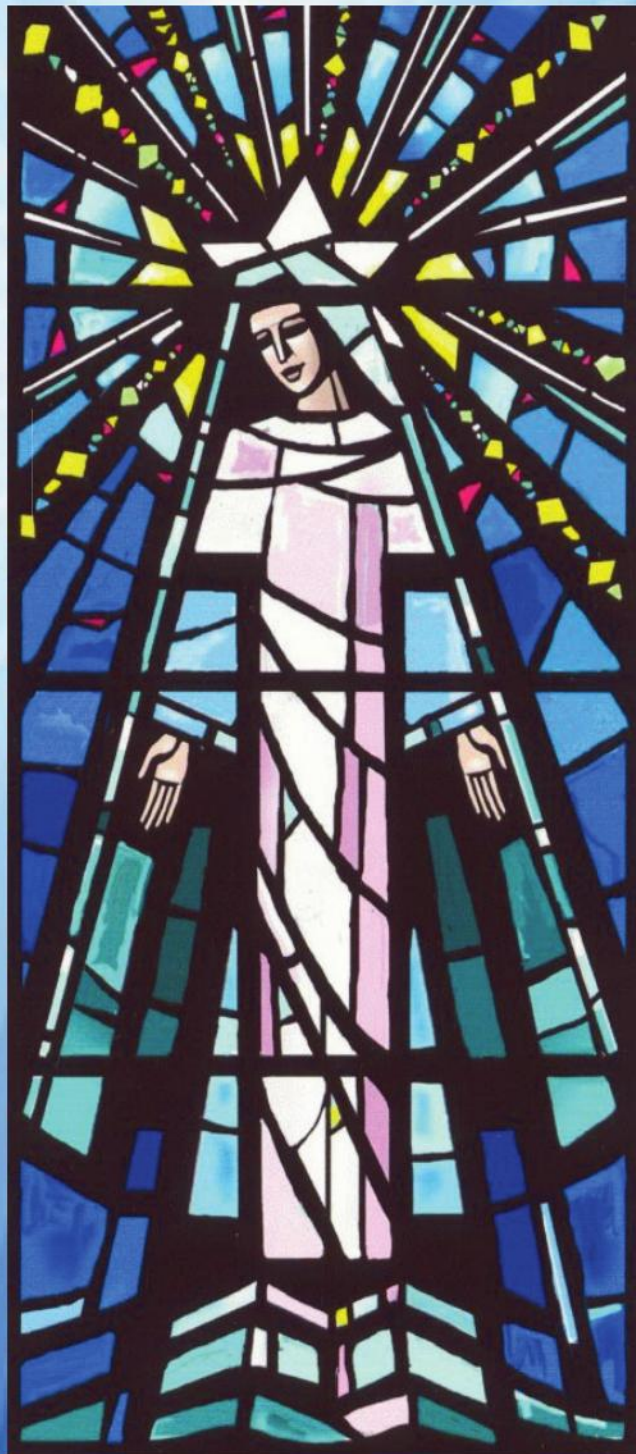

ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka



I know we are to listen to the Word of God. It is important to do such. Why? Because God is telling us to do something and I figure He knows much more than me! He brought forth all of creation. He sent Jesus to earth to save us and rose Jesus from the dead! Why wouldn't we listen to God?? (Do we think we know more than God?). So when God speaks, we should listen!

I love this Gospel account we hear this Sunday from Mark's Gospel.

The apostles gathered together with Jesus and reported all they had done and taught. He said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." Jesus knows us so well that we need to rest a while. Of course we know Sunday is a day of rest, as God rested on the 7th day after creating the other 6 days. We have the Sabbath or the day of rest so we can recharge. On this day of rest every Sunday we are also commanded to keep holy the Sabbath and for Catholics that is to gather with other Catholics at the Table of the Lord to hear God's Word and receive His Body and Blood, coming together every Sunday as the Body of Christ to celebrate Mass. However, in this scripture account I hear Jesus say every now and then we need to take a longer rest, to go away, even by yourself, and rest. That is always great news what we hear from Jesus.

So if Jesus is saying that, I am listening and I am going!! A bit of rest is calling me up north for a week or so but know this rest does not mean I stop praying for you. If you have a few moments yourself, please offer a few prayers for me as well. I appreciate it!

Stewardship Thoughts

Today's Scripture readings present the theme of the Good Shepherd. The prophet Jeremiah warns those shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock that their evil deeds will not go unpunished. He prophesies about Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who God will lift up as a righteous shoot from David's line. St. Paul, in his Letter to the Ephesians, reminds us how, through Christ, we are brought together in Him. In St. Mark's Gospel, Jesus shows compassion by taking pity on the crowd, the lost sheep, and begins to teach them many things. How can we seek a deeper relationship with Christ, the Good Shepherd? Do we, in love and a spirit of evangelization, encourage our brothers and sisters who have left the faith to reopen their hearts to Jesus — to allow Him personally into their lives? Begin by asking them to attend Alpha or another evangelization series at your parish.

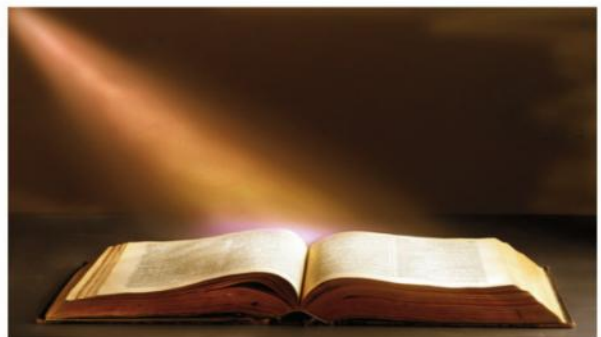

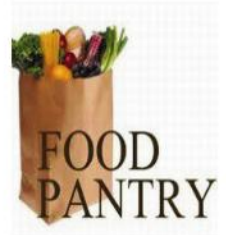

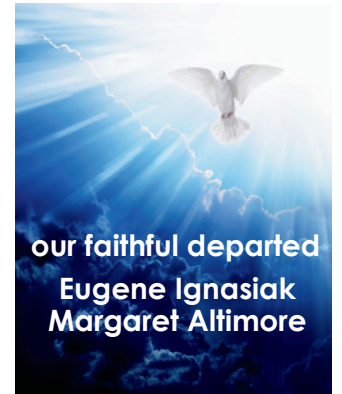
