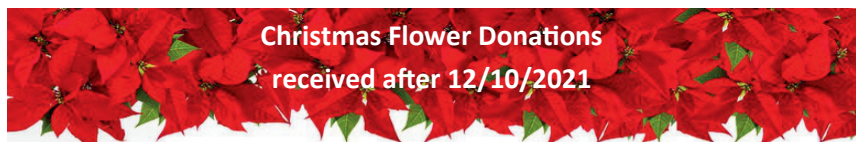

## Music Notes from Glenn Miller

### *“What Child Is This”, and “As With Gladness”*

Two of our hymns today, “What Child Is This?” and “As With Gladness” were written by William Chatterton Dix, who lived in Glasgow, Scotland, where he worked as a manager of an insurance company. A gifted writer, he wrote two devotional books, translated hymns from Greek, and wrote several collections of poetry. He wrote these hymns when he was afflicted by an unexpected and severe illness that resulted in him being bedridden and suffering from severe depression. During this illness he had a near-death experience which brought about a spiritual renewal in him while he was recovering. While recovering he read the Bible comprehensively and was inspired to author many hymns, including these two.

“What Child Is This” was originally titled, “The Manger Throne;” version in our hymnbook and in most hymnbook repeats the same text as the refrain, “...this, this is Christ the King, whom shepherds guard and angels sing...” Its original version of the hymn however is much more comprehensive, and even foreshadows Holy Week:

*What Child is this who, laid to rest  
On Mary's lap is sleeping?  
Whom Angels greet with anthems sweet,  
While shepherds watch are keeping?  
This, this is Christ the King,  
Whom shepherds guard and angels sing;  
Haste, haste, to bring Him laud,  
The Babe, the Son of Mary.*

*Why lies He in such mean estate,  
Where ox and ass are feeding?  
Good Christians, fear, for sinners here  
The silent Word is pleading.  
Nails, spear shall pierce Him through,  
The cross be borne for me, for you.  
Hail, hail the Word made flesh,  
The Babe, the Son of Mary.*

*So bring Him incense, gold and myrrh,  
Come peasant, king to own Him;  
The King of kings salvation brings,  
Let loving hearts enthrone Him.  
Raise, raise a song on high,  
The Virgin sings her lullaby.  
Joy, joy for Christ is born,  
The Babe, the Son of Mary.*



The tune used for this text, Greensleeves, is a traditional English ballad which dates from 1580. It is named after a Ladie Greene Sleeves. It enjoyed great popularity, and was even used in numerous plays of the time, including by William Shakespeare in the *Merry Wives of Windsor*.

Dix wrote “As With Gladness Men of Old” after reading the Gospel lesson for today.

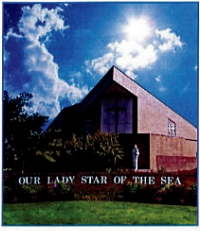

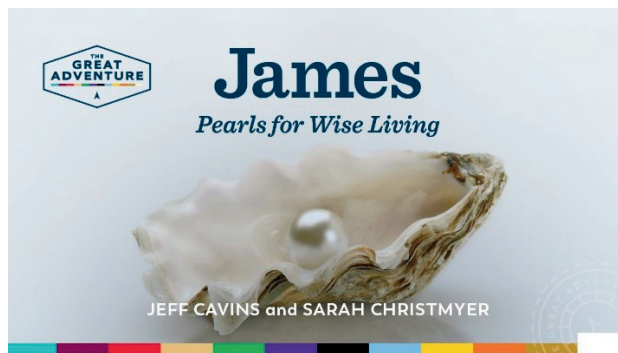
