ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes. **Adults over 21** need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Over 60 abortions have taken place in the United States since the 1973 decisions of *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton*. When Pope Francis refers to “throwaway culture” this is what he means. However, we have great trust in God’s providence. We are reminded time and again in Scripture to seek the Lord’s help, and as people of faith, we believe that our prayers are heard.

**** Monday is the national honoring the life and work of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. (A reminder that the parish office will be closed.)** Last January, Archbishop Gomez of Los Angeles said, “We do not love those who oppose us because they are loveable, or even likable, Rev. King once said. We love them because God loves them. And by our love, we seek their conversion and friendship, not their humiliation. This is our Christian duty in this moment — to be healers and peacemakers, to overcome evil and lies, not by more of the same, but with words of truth and works of love.” Let us pray to Our Lady Queen of Peace for a greater understanding of true peace and love in our hearts, expressed in our words and actions.

May the Lord’s peace reign in our lives this week.

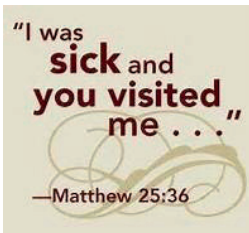
Participants will meet every week to view an engaging video presentation followed by small group discussion and fellowship.
