The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

We certainly know lent as a season of fasting. We probably think lent less as a time of feasting. Maybe we can consider both this lent.

Yes there are the two days in lent that we officially “fast,” ie., Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. However, many people do other fasting as part of their lenten sacrifice. They might fast from pizza, chocolate, alcohol, desserts, pop, etc. Other fast from other activities in their daily life, e.g., social media, texting, computer games, television, etc. These are those things we do that we know we do too much of! The ultimate goal is, after Lent is over, some of our fasting continues because we have come to realize that we don’t need all that stuff anyway!

While it is good for us to fast during lent, we can feast as well. There are some solemnities or high feast days, e.g., the Annunciation of the Lord on Mach 25. Particularly on these days we are exempt from our fasting in order to truly celebrate the feast! If “feasting” is engaging in more, there is some feasting that can be good for us every day during Lent! Like feasting (spending more time) on prayer or daily Mass. We can feast on praying the Rosary everyday. We can feast by simply spending time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, even just 15 minutes a day if we have never done that. We can feast by spending more time reading sacred scripture, performing works of charity, providing words of encouragement to others or acts of charity, etc. I think you get the point.

Very often people are asked or they say what they are giving up (fasting) for Lent,. Let’s also ask ourselves how will we be feasting this lent? It is not just giving up but what can I do more of that will then become more of a habit in my life after Lent is over and we celebrate Easter and beyond? After all, if Lent is meant to rid ourselves of some of the bad stuff in our life, it is also a time to replace those things with good things that bring out the loving saint God created us to be!!

**** Last weekend at some of the Masses I mentioned the special message that was emailed to the parishioners mid week. Some were surprised and said they did not get any such message or letter. Some others mentioned they stopped receiving the email newsletter from the parish that goes out every Saturday morning. **We have been working on this and believe we have found a solution. If you are not receiving this email *still*, and wish to be, please contact us and let us know. This has become a great tool for us to communicate with our community.****

Here are some things we do know. 1) For you to receive periodic emails from the parish, we have to have your email address! If you have not received anything, please go to our website olsos.org under Get Connected and follow the directions. 2) If you used to get emails from us every week but not now, check your JUNK or SPAM folders and then move one or more of what you found from us to you INBOX. 3) It is best if you click the email when receiving one from us instead of just scrolling through the preview. Opening the email lets your computer know you read these and you should then be always getting them in your inbox. 4) If you are unsure about any of this, ask a 4th or 5th grader to help you!

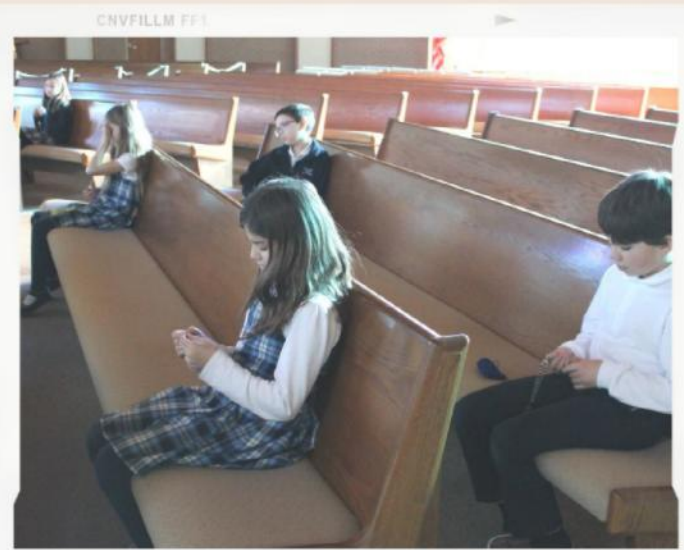

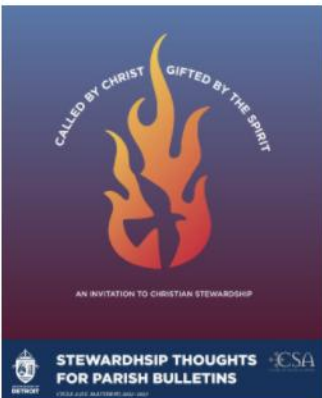

Stewardship Thoughts : A common theme in today's Scripture passages is avoiding temptation. The passage from the Book of Genesis tells of Adam and Eve's fall from grace, which establishes Catholic teaching on original sin. In Psalm 51, the psalmist sings of God's mercy and forgiveness. St. Paul alerts the Roman community to God's gift of grace in Jesus Christ, and to how, through one righteous act, acquittal and life came to all. St. Matthew's Gospel retells Jesus' 40 days of fasting in the desert, culminating in the devil's fruitless temptations of Christ. Temptations distract us from developing a personal relationship with Jesus and hinder Christian stewards from doing His will. These temptations can also lead to sin. Yet, even when we fail, His mercy is always available through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
