
Patty was a member of our school faculty and administration for 39 years, died January 30, 2023 in Florida. She touched so many lives during her long career here at Star.

In today's reading from the Book of Genesis, God invites Abram (later Abraham) to a new land, promising to bless him and make of him a great nation. 
