## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka



Next weekend I am very pleased to welcome to our community Fr. Steven Bell, CSP. Fr. Bell is a Paulist priest and will be here for our parish mission. Fr. Bell was here a few years back and I know people were so delighted in what he had to say, how he said it, and how his message lingered on. He is delighted to return to Star of the Sea for this parish Mission.

Fr. Bell will be focusing on the fears in our life and how to live our faith with or despite our fears. We all have fears don't we? I know we do because I hear it from just about everyone. Fears about health issues, family situations, work relationships and situations, financial difficulties, and some even fear for their life. We can't turn on the news or read various news accounts without hearing about the fears people have regarding the very basics of everyday life. What do we do about those fears, especially when it comes to our faith? How can we still trust in the Lord? How does prayer help us face our fears? How does the power of the Eucharist help our fears and live our life in the Lord Jesus?

I hope all of you are able to set aside 60-75 minutes for three nights and come to the Mission. So few minutes for such wonderful insight and help for you life and your faith! I also believe you will find Fr. Bell quite entertaining while delivering a profound message. He is just that type of guy!! You will get a chance to hear Fr. Bell first at next Sunday Masses as he will preach at all of them. Then please make plans to return next Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday night at 7 pm. Invite others in your family or down the block or across the city that you know would benefit from his message. Who else do you know that is being oppressed by various fears in their life...invite them to the mission. They have little to lose and so much to gain!
