## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

“Be who you is and not who you ain’t. Cuz when you ain’t who you is, you is who you ain’t. And that ain’t good!” Did you ever hear anyone say that? Did you ever repeat that to someone?? Four years ago Fr. Steven Bell had that ringing in our heads during that Parish Mission! Many of you had that phrase down for a long time!!

Well, I am very happy to welcome back to Our Lady Star of the Sea Fr. Steven Bell, CSP. **Paulist Fr. Steven Bell** leads parish missions, retreats, revivals and workshops, all of which consider the importance of réconciliation and healing.

Fr. Steve previously served as associate director of Newman Hall / Holy Spirit Parish at the University of California at Berkeley and associate director of St. Thomas More Newman Center at The Ohio State University in Columbus, OH. (Go easy on him Wolverine fans he was just doing his ministry...and those Buckeyes needed him!)

Fr. Steve serves on the board of directors of Fellowships at Auschwitz for the Study of Professional Ethics (FASPE). He is a faculty member for FASPE's seminary program where he engages with seminary and medical graduate students and professionals on ethics.

A native of Washington, D.C., Fr. Steve was ordained a priest on June 22, 2008, by then-Archbishop Edwin O'Brien of the Archdiocese of Baltimore.

I know you will find Fr. Steve inspiring, insightful and even entertaining. I hope all of you come to each night of the Mission, Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday at 7 pm. His preaching will be about 60 minutes"ish" because sometime you just can't curtail the Holy Spirit flowing through him! This is the focus point of the parish for Lent. I pray it will benefit you, and those whom you encounter, not only through Lent but beyond.

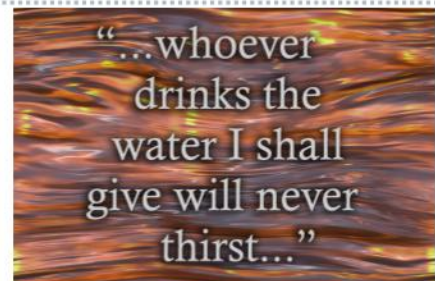

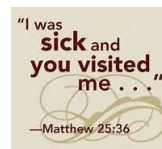
