Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

On this Second Sunday of Easter, also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. It was Saint Pope John Paul II that assigned the title "Divine Mercy Sunday" to the Second Sunday of Easter. He personally knew Saint Faustina, the religious sister in Poland to whom Our Lord appeared under the title of Divine Mercy. Saint John Paul II shared in the special devotion of St. Faustina and was the one who helped promote her canonization. How amazing and appropriate that he died the evening before the liturgical celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday in 2005.

The image of Divine Mercy, i.e., a depiction of Christ with red and white rays emanating from his heart, is on display by our Easter cross however you usually find it the rest of the year by our confessional.

Jesus wants us to know of his great mercy, but we need to place our trust in him. Today we need to know of Christ's mercy more than ever. We see many divisions, conflicts, with so many people searching for peace in life. We need to know that it is in Jesus that we find shelter and refuge. Especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we find an abundance of Christ's mercy freely given for us. Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, so often talks about our need to open up our hearts to receive the Lord's mercy and to share it with others!

Thanks to Mrs. Jennifer Koester and the school youth chorale for their singing at the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper and Palm Sunday. Thanks to Brian Ebner for coordinating all the maintenance demands and the office staff. Thanks to our small group of altar servers who volunteered to serve the additional Triduum liturgies. It was great teamwork on the part of all. Everyone "worked overtime" to make these holy days special and beautiful. We are grateful for their hard work and perseverance.

\*\* People sometime ask, "Which is more demanding, Christmas or Easter?" Christmas has its own set of liturgical and cultural demands but for the most part it is the same celebration repeated many times. The Triduum is really three very different and demanding liturgies, all musically different, plus the additional three Easter Sunday Masses. Easter is much more challenging and demanding on the part of the ministers, especially those involved musically. We are *so blessed by their ministry and grateful* to God for all of them.

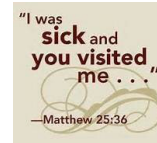
