In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

When people get in a discussion about the Church, it can go so many ways with many different topics. Nonetheless, what is essential? What is the Church called to do... bottom line? I think it comes down to sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ through words and actions in the lives of people in many different life situations.

Our task and our message reminds us of who we are as members of the Catholic Church. We are not an isolated community. We belong to a larger Body. A larger living organism that is able to do more than we could ever possibly do ourselves. Here at the parish, we certainly benefit from many of the Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) funded programs and ministries. But what is more important is that it enables each one of us to *participate* in the wide reaching arms of the Church to those in need, i.e., those in need of education, encouragement, counseling, organization, spiritual renewal, conscience and religious formation, and Christian outreach in many ways. The programs and ministries of the CSA does far more than we can ever do, either as individual or as this parish community. It puts into action that which we pray about and profess at Sunday Mass. It helps us to reach out to our society which is in such great need to hear the Word of Christ and change its culture to ways of love.

Yes - we expect many services in many places, e.g., hospital chaplains, college campus Newman Centers, youth and young adult outreach, etc., but maybe don't bother to think who provides or funds all of our expectations or programs that we take for granted. The CSA is not about money. It is about mission. Yes, as with everything, money is needed for the mission to be accomplished. The bottom line is that **we** have to provide it. Somehow these ministries and programs need to be funded by the "larger Church" because they are beyond separate and individual parishes. In the Archdiocese of Detroit, all of this and more is funded by the CSA. And the real beauty is that one gift, one pledge, shares in over 170 vital ministries and programs.

As you know, each parish in the Archdiocese of Detroit is given a CSA target" (which they must meet either from the direct contributions of the parishioners or else it comes from the operational budget). Money pledged and received in excess of the target is returned to the parish without any further assessment – so every cent comes back to the parish free and clear! [This is how many parishes fund special projects. We are doing exactly that as we **Raise the Roof** during the next three years.] It is also important to know that the distribution of the CSA money is overseen by the lay Archdiocesan Finance Council and none of it has ever been used, or will be used, for any lawsuits or any special projects outside the Archdiocese, other than those US Conference of Catholic Bishops collections. All the money goes exactly to those programs and ministries stated in the Catholic Services Appeal.

I hope that each household finds something within their means to support the CSA and our **Raise the Roof** campaign. Even \$5 is an important gift if it comes from one's treasure! (There is an easy way to charge your gift or give online so please give us a call and we can assist you in the process.) Your generosity has been very much appreciated in the past because it gets to the heart of the mission of the Catholic Church. Remember, your gift is far reaching in opening doors for people to encounter Jesus. May God continue to bless you in your sharing of the future ministries and programs in our Church of Detroit.

Stewardship Thoughts

Today's Scripture readings hold powerful stewardship messages. In St. John's Gospel, Jesus informs the Apostles — and us — that He is the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. Our discipleship in Christ instituted at our Baptism, which draws us closer to Him, paves the way to the Father. In the Acts of the Apostles, the Christian community in Jerusalem appoints deacons to show the significance of sharing resources with those brothers and sisters in need. In St. Peter's First Letter, he reminds us that while accepting our Lord's gift of faith makes us special to God, faith comes at a high cost. Christian stewards acknowledge faith as a gift built from the graces flowing from praying daily, attending Mass regularly and receiving Holy Communion, and reading Scripture. In our continuing stewardship journey, do we use God's graces and gifts to strengthen our faith, so that we can then share that faith with those we encounter?

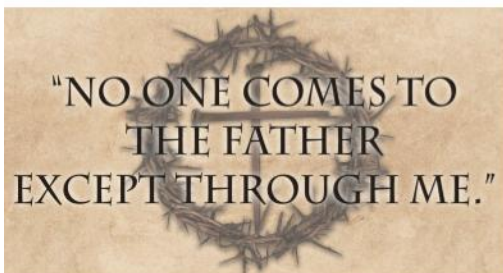

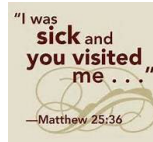
