MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Happy Mothers' Day!!

One of the many, many items that usually fall to mom in the early days of our life is teaching us to say our prayers. They teach us to pray in the morning, at night, before meals and at special times for special help. They also teach us the importance of the sacraments and participating in Sunday Mass every Sunday.

It is only fitting, then, for us to pray for our mothers today.

Holy God, you compared your own love for all your people to the love of a mother for her children. Look with kindness on our mother who has shared in your creating love by the gift of her children.

We thank you for the joys and sorrows of her life, the giving and sharing, and, especially for your love that has formed us in your image.

Listen to our prayers and bless the mother who has nurtured and sustained us. Give us patience in abundance and let her find joy and satisfaction in all her work.

Glory and praise to you, loving God, through Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, and who reigns with you in the glory of heaven, for ever and ever.

I thank God for my mother who kept reminder of our faith by making sure a few religious articles were in our house, e.g., a last supper image, a crucifix, a stature of Mary or another saint, and an outdoor shrine to Our Lady. She would also help me to get to church when I was assigned to serve the weekday 6:15 morning Mass!

Let's also keep in our thoughts and prayers those women who are not able to be mothers for various reasons and those who have experienced miscarriages. Our Blessed Mother knows the goodness of their heart and desire.

- ** The Catholic Services Appeal is now under way. I can't stress enough the importance of the ministries and programs funded by the CSA. Through the CSA the Church does its "work" or lives out it's mission of bringing Christ to others through many ways and means, e.g., formation programs at Sacred Heart Major Seminary, college, hospital and prison chaplaincies, the Catholic Television Network, support for pro-life initiatives, Mass for Shut -Ins, etc. The parish receives many services as provided by the CSA programs and ministries, e.g., catechist formation, maintenance workshops, school services, financial services, liturgical formation, and much, much more. The outreach of 170 CSA supported ministries and programs are felt not only in our parish but also beyond our borders. Please remember: any excess of the parish target is returned to the parish. Thanks for all your sacrifices and your generosity and making a pledge or gift to the CSA. You have received CSA information in the mail or you can also use the envelope in your packet of envelopes, to make your pledge or gift. Any checks should be made payable to "Catholic Services Appeal." Please also note that we are using the CSA to fund the Raise the Roof campaign here in the parish. (This summer the elementary school roof will be replaced, with the other roofs being replaced the following two summers.) So please consider an extra gift to the CSA, or the parish through the CSA, explicitly for the Roof. Using the CSA to raise the \$750,000 needed for this summer will also save the parish approximately \$52,000!! I know raising funds for a roof is not glamourous, but you all know the need, and importance, of a good roof to protect the treasures in your own homes!
- ** We have seen the announcements from the World Health Organization declaring that Covid-19 is no longer a public health emergency. Though it is still taking many lives each day, the severe emergency no long exists. With that in mind it is timely to invite people back to the regular, weekly celebration of Sunday Mass in person. The obligation of participating in Sunday Mass, every Sunday, is still in Church




