Happy Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord!

This is one of the great Feasts of the Liturgical Year that is shared with many different Christian denominations just like Good Friday and Pentecost. We find in the verses of the first chapter of the Acts of the Apostles Jesus being taken up to Heaven. Traditionally, for many years, this day was celebrated 40 days after Easter. That being a Thursday

is why it is generally called "Ascension Thursday." Many years ago, the Vatican gave permission for some countries to move the celebration from Thursday to the following Sunday. In the USA, in 1999, that decision was delegated to the provinces of the United States Council of Catholic Bishops. (For us, we are in the province of Michigan.) Presently, the provinces of Boston, Hartford, New York, Newark, Omaha, and Philadelphia have retained their celebration to remain on Thursday. My recollection, back to that time, is that most of the country decided to move the celebration of the Feast to a Sunday because very few people were celebrating it, though it was a Holyday of Obligation. Because of the importance of the feast, moving it to a Sunday obviously made it much more convenient for the people to celebrate it.

An option for the opening prayer for today gives a good summary of this celebration and the hope we have in this day for ourselves. "Gladden us with holy joys, almighty God, and make us rejoice with devout thanksgiving, for the Ascension of Christ you Son is our exaltation, and, where the Head has gone before in glory, the Body is called to follow in hope."




Men's Club Fee: \$25 per family.
