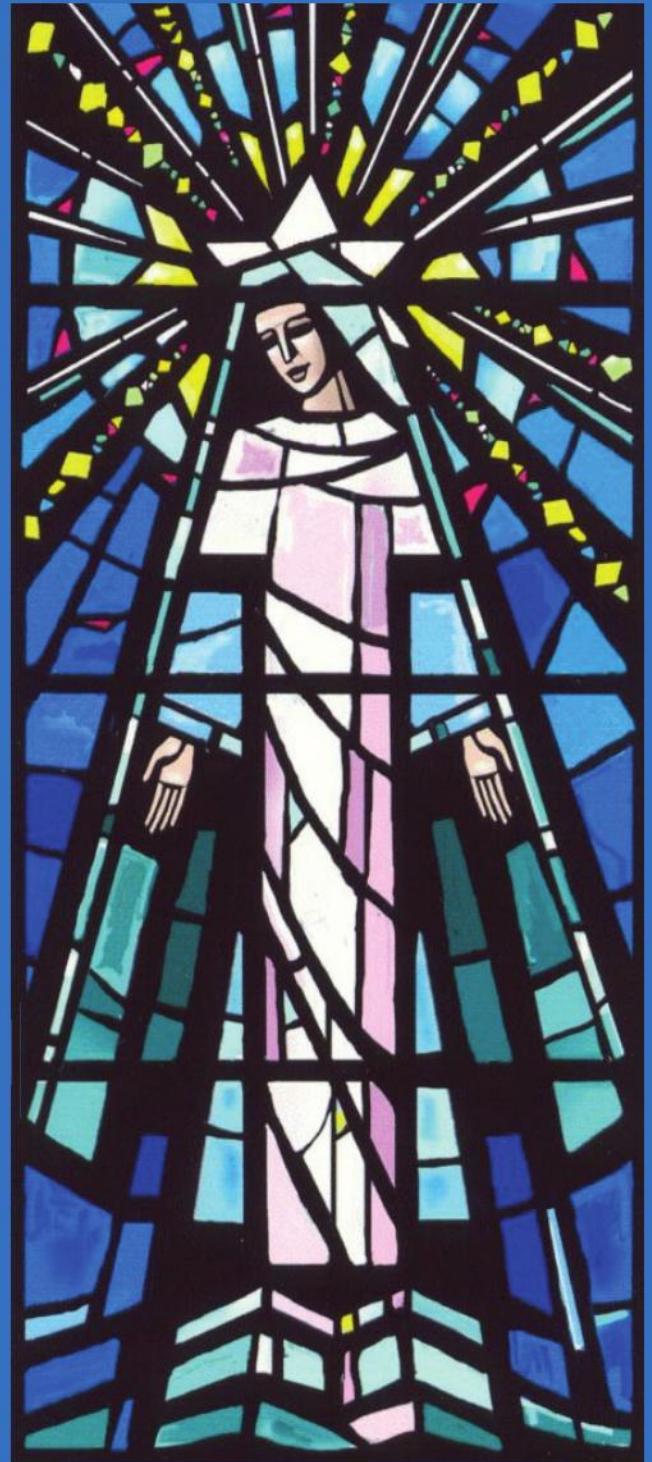

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

This week we celebrate the 69th anniversary of the founding of Our Lady Star of the Sea Parish. It was on June 26, 1954, that this parish was established to bring Christ to others and spread the Good News in this specific corner of the Archdiocese of Detroit.

Sixty-seven years in Church's "time" is not greatly significant, especially since the Church universal has many "church" buildings hundreds of years old and people are still gathering in those churches or parishes to worship and as a community they advance the Kingdom of God. Nonetheless, we know 69 years for us is rather significant! From starting with a small gathering of new parishioners, coming from our surrounding sister parishes, we have grown nicely in this part of town. The importance of our faith these many years brought forth an elementary and middle school and eventually an all-girls high school. Unfortunately, as with so many schools in the 70s and 80s, the high school had to close. However, the pursuance of academic excellence continues in our elementary and middle school, and accredited school of excellence, a hidden gem in the GP community! Our outreach to the community continues. Our gathering as a worshipping community continues to challenge and enhance us as the living Body of Christ! Yes, 69 years of dedicated service, education, and worship.

I know there are still a few of you who have been around all 69 years and remember when the first Masses were held in Parcels school. Most of you have seen continual improvements in and around our campus to better serve the parish community for years to come. Time marks us as to where we have come from and yet opens the path for our future direction. Christ has always wanted his disciples to bring His message, His timeless Truth and Life, to the present-day world as it evolves. May we continue to not only follow the Lord but teach and preach the Risen Christ in new ways so all may come to encounter His living presence. May we, one and all, come to see and encounter Christ and be open to the movement of the Holy Spirit in our life! The Church calls each one of us into this "new evangelization" as we build on our foundation and move toward the future.

Thank you for the time, talent and treasure you provide in support of the parish and its programs and ministries. Without you providing that support, we cannot exist. May Our Lady smile upon us as we continue to do all we can to bring others to Christ to live the love of God.

** While the parish is 69 years old, our school is 67 years old. As many of you realize, when things get older, well, some things need to get replaced! It is time for our elementary school roof to be replaced so we don't incur further damage to our building with a bad roof! This year, we replace the lower school roof. Next year we replace the middle school (the former high school) roof and then in the summer of 2025 the church roof. I know it is not glamorous and exciting as seeing a new addition going up but you all know the necessity of a good roof to protect the people and the treasures under it! Fall Sport Registration Period May 6 - June 30, 2023 (Sports offered: Girls Volleyball Grades 4-8) fee \$200.00/ player.

Winter Sport Registration Period: May 6 - September 30, 2023 (Sports offered: Boys/ Girls Basketball) Grades 3-8 fee \$200.00/ player. Depending on # of players registered 3rd/4th graders may play in an instructional basketball program vs CYO.
Grades K-2 intramural program \$125.00/ player.
Grades 2-8 "Club" Cheerleading \$125.00/ player.


Spring Sport Registration Period: (Sports combined w/ St Joan and St Paul: Girls Softball, Boys Baseball) Grades 5-8 fee TBD.

Men's Club Fee: \$25 per family.

Sports physical exam is required each year to be eligible to participate in CYO athletics or the 3/4 grade instructional basketball program. **The physical must be dated by the doctor after April 15, 2023.** No student will be allowed to try out for any sport without having a sports physical on file with the Athletic Department. There are no exceptions to this requirement.

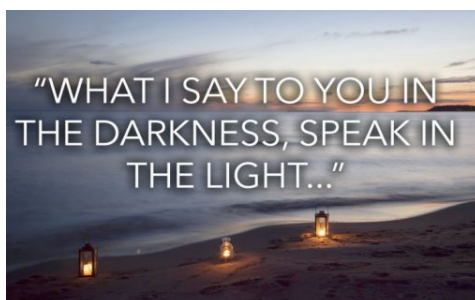
