

This Sunday we celebrate the *Rite of Enrollment* with our young candidates who desire to be confirmed in the spring of next year. In this Rite they express their commitment and engagement during this more intense period of study and reflection in preparation of receiving the Holy Spirit and the Sacrament. The Sacrament of Confirmation, like all the sacraments we receive, is not

meant to be "one and done" but only the beginning of God's Grace in an aspect of our life. The Sacrament of Confirmation is not some type of graduation of religious education, or faith formation, but only the beginning of *putting into action* the faith received on the day of baptism.

Please pray for our candidates and their families making this commitment this Sunday. We all know the struggles in today's age and culture to "keep holy the sabbath" and live out the Church's teaching that we are obligated to participate in Sunday Eucharist each and every Sunday. [I often wonder if many catholics somehow think that we only have to "go to church" on Christmas and Easter!] There are many pressures today to do plenty of other things instead of encountering the Lord, in his Word and in his Body and Blood, to nurture us and change us to become what we consume. Last Sunday's opening prayer said it clearly, ... "grant that we may always conform our will to yours." The Post Communion also hit the nail on the head: "Grant, O Lord, we pray, that, benefiting from participation in heavenly things, we may be helped by what you give us in this present age and prepared for the gifts that are eternal." God knows what we need, that is why we are told to come together each and every Sunday and celebrate all that God gives us, especially the Body and Blood of Jesus. When you are tempted to do something else in place of Sunday Eucharist, just ask the Holy Spirit, received in Baptism and Confirmation, to help you celebrate the Eucharist and give witness to your faith!

- ** Remember this Wednesday is All Saints Day and a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses at 7:30 am, 10 am, and 7 pm. Thursday we Commemorate All Souls with a Mass of Remembrance at 7 pm, specially recalling those who have been buried from our parish in the past year All are welcome to participate in this Mass and recall all the faithful departed.
- ** The past weeks we made more improvements on our campus for increased safety. You have seen some new concrete, especially n front of school and in Mary's garden. There was a little more work outside the Prayer Chapel and in the school playground. I am thankful that we try and fix that which is needed to be changed for the safety of all and not delay maintenance that only makes it more difficulty to do as the years go on. We also put in all new LED parking lot lights which has very nicely illuminated the lot. That should be good for us for another 8 years or more.

PARISH REGISTRATION


Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours.

Favorite thing about teaching:


Watching my students learn and grow as the school year progresses.
