ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

We certainly know lent as a season of fasting. After all, it is one of the three “pillars” of Lent, along with prayer and almsgiving. We probably think lent less as a time of feasting. Maybe we can consider both this lent.

Yes there are the two days in lent that we officially “fast,” ie., Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. However, many people do other fasting as part of their lenten sacrifice. They might fast from pizza, chocolate, alcohol, desserts, pop, etc. Other fast from other activities in their daily life, e.g., social media, texting, computer games, television, etc. These are those things we do that we know we do too much of! The ultimate goal is, after Lent is over, some of our fasting continues because we have come to realize that we don’t need all that stuff anyway!

While it is good for us to fast during lent, we can feast as well. We like to feast don’t we? If “feasting” is engaging in more, there is some feasting that can be good for us every day during Lent! Like feasting (spending more time) on prayer or daily Mass. We can feast on praying the Rosary everyday. We can feast by simply spending time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, even just 15 minutes a day if we have never done that. We can feast by spending more time reading sacred scripture, performing works of charity, providing words of encouragement to others or acts of charity, etc. I think you get the point.

Very often people are asked or they say what they are giving up (fasting) for Lent,. Let’s also ask ourselves how will we be feasting this lent? It is not just giving up, but what can “I do more of” that will then become more of a habit in my life after Lent is over and we celebrate Easter and beyond? After all, if Lent is meant to rid ourselves of some of the bad stuff in our life, it is also a time to replace those things with good things that bring out the loving saint God created us to be!!

I strongly encourage you to sign up for the “I am here” lent challenge. Go to “iamhere.org” or see the link on our parish website and sign up for this little trivia game and learn a bit more about what goes on at Mass, the different parts and elements, etc. You might be surprised how much more you will know about the Mass after Lent! You will also find some amazing stories about Mass and the eucharist in the lives of our brothers and sisters at the website, “iamhere.org”

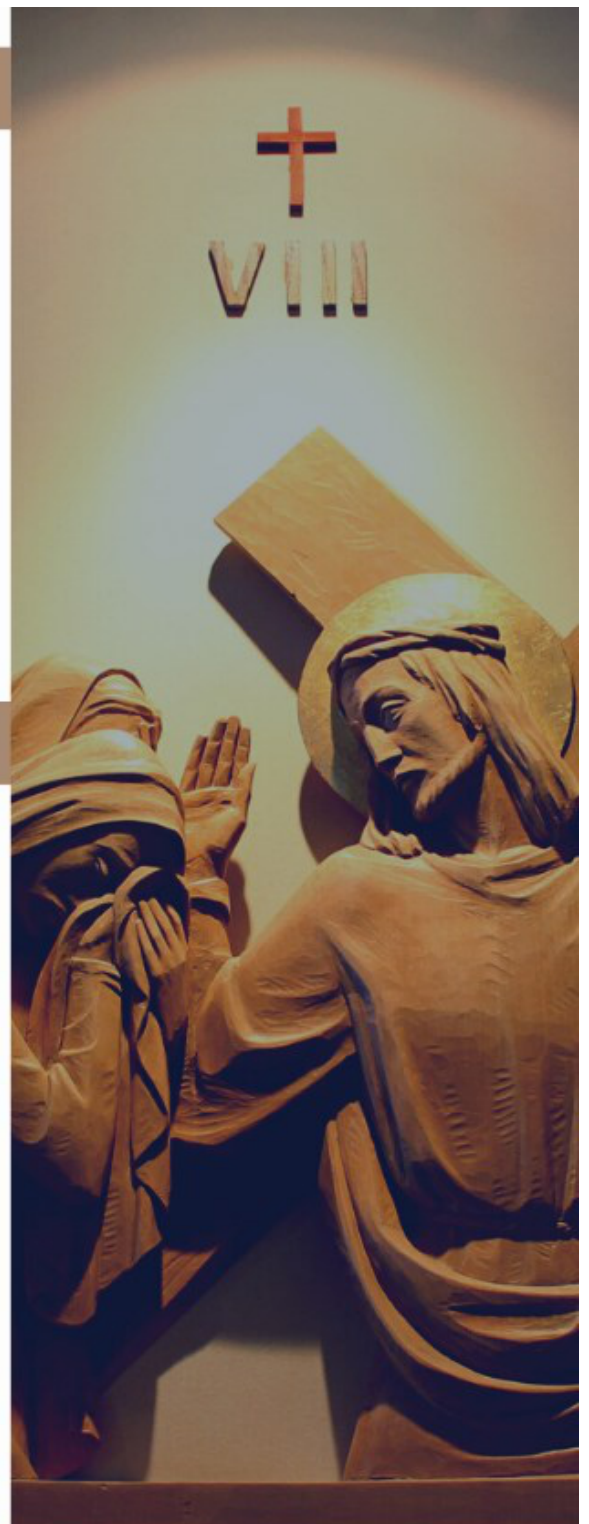
ST VINCENT DE PAUL - OLSOS CONFERENCE

Stewardship Thoughts

Baptism and repentance is the common theme in today's Scripture passages. In Genesis, God establishes a covenant with Noah and his descendants: *that never again shall all bodily creatures be destroyed by the waters of a flood.* St. Peter, in his First Letter, references this story of Noah and the flood. He states: *... Eight in all, were saved through water. This prefigured baptism, which saves you now.* In the Sacrament of Baptism, our sin is forgiven, and we are called to discipleship in Christ, our Lord and Savior. Baptism is the "gateway" to all of the sacraments. At the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday Masses, we strengthen our discipleship by renewing our baptismal promises, vowing to reject Satan, his empty promises, and the glamour of evil in our lives. In St. Mark's Gospel, the evangelist tells how Jesus *remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan.* We know Jesus was successful in resisting this temptation. May we seek the Lord's grace in times of weakness so we, too, can avoid temptation that leads to sin. During this Lenten season, participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation to prepare yourself for the Risen Christ.
