Must be a registered member, in good standing, of OLSOS.

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

Next weekend we welcome Fr. Honest Manishi, C.S.Sp.. He is a member of the Congregation of the Holy Spirit, commonly known as the Holy Ghost Fathers or the Spiritans. Many of you might have come in contact with the Spiritans, or the Holy Ghost Fathers, because they have been the ministers of downtown Old St. Mary's parish since 1893. Correct, 1893 *not* 1983! You know the church... right there in Greektown by the casino!

The website for the Spiritans gives a nice summary of their mission. "Spiritans are committed to respectful evangelization. Through education and community service, we endeavor to help the oppressed and disadvantaged overcome the problems that make each day a struggle. From our witness and service, we hope to introduce people to the Holy Gospel and God's love for them."

Fr. Honest Manishi will speak to us on behalf of the missionary diocese of Zanzibar, Tanzania, and the bishop, Augustine Shao, C.S.Sp.. Zanzibar consists of two islands in the United Republic of Tanzania and made up of many faiths, but the Christian minority is less than 2% of the population with the majority being Muslim.

Besides their peace building initiatives, the diocese tries to provide educational, medical and many other social services for people. In providing these necessities, it given them an opportunity to talk about the faith and make people aware of Jesus. I am sure Fr. Honest will be sharing more specifics about their missionary outreach in the diocese.

Each parish in the Archdiocese of Detroit participates in the "Missionary Co-op Plan." This is a coordinated effort to help the many missionary congregations, dioceses, or institutes raise awareness of their missionary efforts around the world and ask for necessary resources. This plan ensures an even distribution, if you will, of all the missionary groups with the parishes of the AoD. Your generosity is very much appreciated and certainly a blessing in accomplishing the evangelical outreach of these ministries.

**** This Wednesday, June 26**, we celebrate the 70th Anniversary of our parish founding. Fr. Ralph Barton guided the parish for its first 26 years. He built the "temporary" church with the intention that it would be converted into a gymnasium or a parish hall. (That is the usual vision and plan with first church buildings.) However, providing quality education became a top priority so the elementary school and then the convent were the first buildings after the church. Then it was the high school for girls followed by a gymnasium. The "permanent" church was never built until a committee was formed in 1995. As it says in the Dedication Mass brochure, "experts were invited from the Archdiocese and from Sacred Heart Major Seminary to help educate the committee." Well...lo and behold, I was the expert from Sacred Heart Major Seminary who came to Star of the Sea during that time! I remember also seeing the blueprints for the new church how exciting it was to see the future church. What a blessing the church building, and the parish community, has been and continues to be today! Thanks to all of you who make this a great community! Happy Birthday!

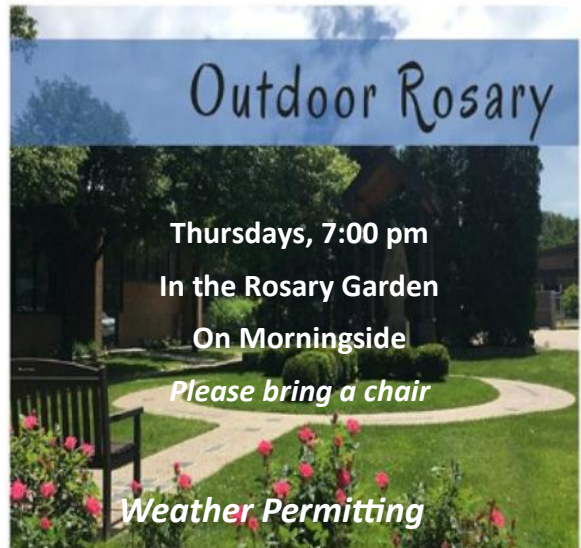

Stewardship Thoughts

The theme of stormy seas links today's readings from the Book of Job, Psalm 107, and St. Mark's Gospel. God addresses Job through a storm. The psalmist proclaims God's command over the stormy seas. The evangelist, St. Mark, retells the story of Jesus scolding His disciples for their lack of faith after He quiets the sea. In turn, they are in great awe of Jesus' power over the wind and the water. St. Paul in his Second Letter to the Corinthians preaches that in Christ, we are a new creation, that *the old things have passed away*. As Christian stewards, we find comfort in the assurance that the Lord is always there to calm the storm during challenging times and to bring peace to our lives.



St Joseph's Helpers Supporters,

St Joseph's helpers continue to assist seniors with safe and secure homes.

Currently, we have found a critical need to provide temporary handicap ramps for seniors in our area who are facing mobility challenges. Many seniors in our community are finding it increasingly difficult to navigate their homes due to temporary disabilities or mobility issues. Something as simple as a step at the entrance of their home can become a significant barrier to their independence and quality of life.

Temporary handicap ramps are a vital solution providing a temporary but effective way for seniors to enter and exit their homes with confidence. Providing these ramps comes with a cost and unfortunately, our resources are limited. Hence, we are turning to our community for help.

Your support will make a real difference in allowing our community seniors to maintain their independence and dignity with portable, temporary ramps our St Joseph's Helpers volunteers can install. Ramps cost about \$1,000 each and have a reusability design which makes them cost-effective. Mrs. M. States: "I have fallen 3 times trying to get down my stairs. I am so happy with this!"

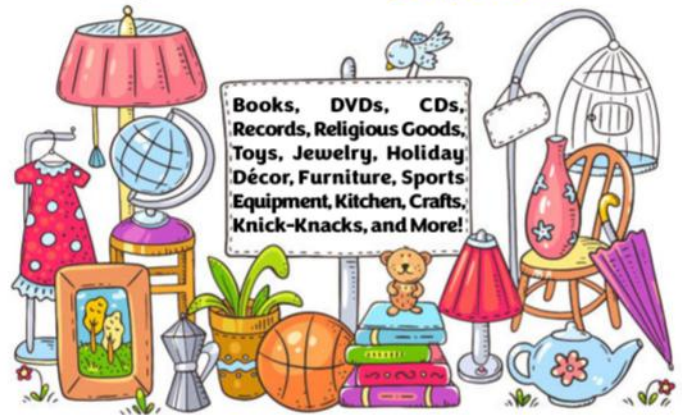
