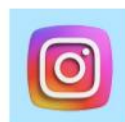

**Mass Intentions - Please Note:** Mass intentions may be arranged by coming into the parish office or online at [www.olsos.org/mass-intentions](http://www.olsos.org/mass-intentions). According to Archdiocesan Policy, the suggested donation is \$10 per Mass per person. Masses can be for the deceased (+) and the living, so please don't assume that a Mass being said for a living person, means that they are ill, please respect the privacy of all individuals. Mass intentions **must be received 14 days prior to publication** to be published and read at Mass.

### MASS INTENTIONS

#### **What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone?**

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

It is worth noting, however, that the offering of the Mass for that intention does not depend on it being publicly voiced but on it being specified in the priest's personal prayers. Similarly, if a priest announces that "I am offering this Mass for [such and such an] intention" he does not thereby require the rest of the congregation to pray for that intention.

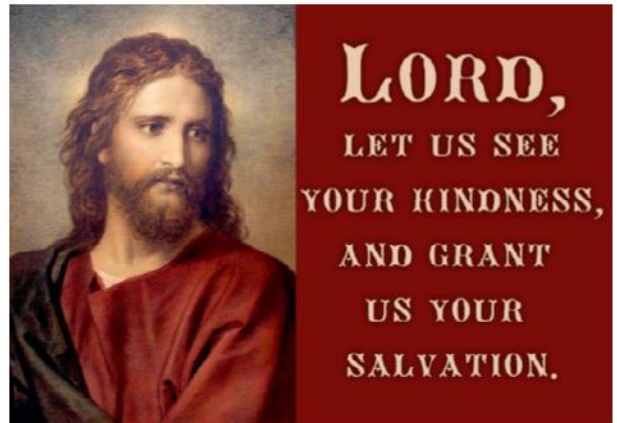
### What is the Anointing of the Sick?

## Stewardship Thoughts

In today's Scripture readings, those called forth to accomplish God's work experience difficulty completing their mission. God directs the prophet Amos, a lowly shepherd, to prophesy to the Israelites in spite of the priest Amaziah's opposition. In St. Mark's Gospel, Jesus sends forth the Twelve Apostles, in the spirit of evangelization, to preach repentance, cure the sick, and drive out demons. He forewarns that they will encounter resistance and even rejection. In his Letter to the Ephesians, St. Paul reminds us of the Father *Who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens*, and to be His adopted heirs. As faithful stewards, we know the cost and sacrifice of discipleship. Our efforts to do God's will may be resisted or rejected. However, the Lord's gift of grace strengthens us to carry out His work regardless of the obstacles we may face. To help discover God's will, set aside a few minutes of quiet time each day to listen to the Lord.
