Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

## Half and Half from Msgr. Gary Smetanka

us!

Who wants to be a catholic? That question probably has fewer hands going up! Yet, it is a most important question. You probably know people in your family, or among friends, who have been thinking about becoming catholic. Maybe they have been influenced by some strong catholics in their relationships, work place, or the wider community. Sometimes individuals hear an inner calling from the Lord to either become baptized or “convert” from another denomination. Sometimes there are individuals who want to become catholic because of a pending marriage, baptism, or another sacrament of the Church. There are people who want to become catholic but don’t know how to go about it.

When you see or hear the acronym “OCIA” in print or conversation, it stands for the *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults*. (Up until the past year, it was referred to as “RCIA” or the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*. The change has come about through an honest understanding of the process, i.e., it is not a simply a rite, or ritual, to become a christian but an *order* or process of initiation, i.e., going from one phase or stage in a spiritual process that ultimately leads to baptism or reception of the sacraments of the Church. It is more than a class or a set of instructions. It is seen as a journey of faith into a deeper faith and union with Christ in the Church.

If you, or someone you know, has been thinking about becoming a member of the Catholic church, please give us a call at the parish office. The process takes a number of months, depending on one’s previous instructions in faith, no matter the denomination or not!

### MASS INTENTIONS

#### *What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone?*

An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

It is worth noting, however, that the offering of the Mass for that intention does not depend on it being publicly voiced but on it being specified in the priest's personal prayers. Similarly, if a priest announces that "I am offering this Mass for [such and such an] intention" he does not thereby require the rest of the congregation to pray for that intention.

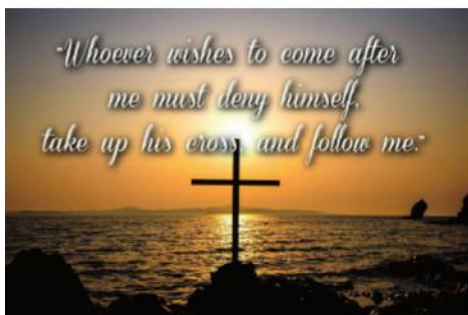

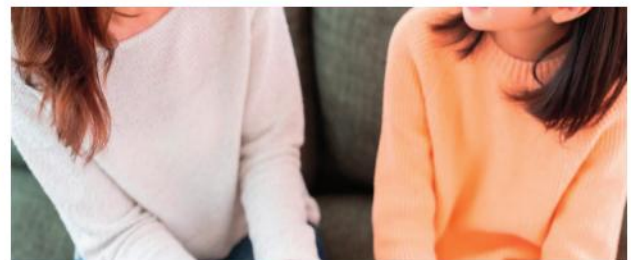

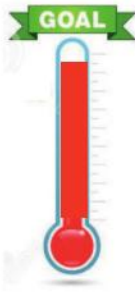

## Stewardship Thoughts

The prophet Isaiah tells us that the Lord God helps us in times of opposition or persecution. 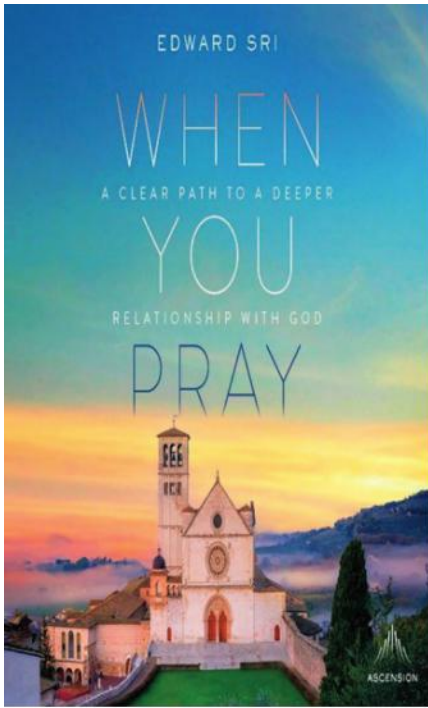
