Items needed: A large bowl or 9x13 cake pan, water, small figures of people or animals (if you have them) <ol style="list-style-type: none">Pour water into the containerIn our Bible story, God caused the Red Sea to part so the Israelites could walk on dry land. Can you part the water? Try using your hands. Did that work?Try using something else. What did you use?Can you think of another time God stopped water for the Israelites? (Read Joshua 3:1 - 4:24)Anytime God uses water to save his people (think about Noah) it is a foreshadowing of a particular sacrament. Do you know what sacrament that is? Where does that sacrament happen in our church?
