1. Opening Prayer (read together)	2. Personal Connection
Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted. Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the land. Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be satisfied. Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. Blessed are the clean of heart [or pure of heart], for they will see God. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God. Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you [falsely] because of me. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven. [Mt. 5:3-12]	Parents- Reflect on then discuss the following: When do you feel the most attuned or connected to Christ? What are you doing in those moments and how can you cultivate that feeling? After sharing, ask your student: Why is it important for Catholic families to be Christ-centric (Christ-centered)? What can we do as a family to make Jesus more central to our family?
